  - 6. In view of above, all these O.As. stand disposed of with liberty to the Respondent The Commissioner, Food and Drugs Administration, Mumbai to take necessary steps in accordance to law. The decision as the case may be shall be communicated to the Applicant. If aggrieved they can avail legal remedy as available in law.
  - 7. It is clarified that all contentions about entitlement of 2<sup>nd</sup> benefits on merits are kept open.
