(iii) Learned P.O. further relied on 'Minutes of Meeting' of P.E.B. held on 29.01.2024 to convey that there were detailed discussions about observations made in 'Para 8 (ii)' Order dated 09.01.2024 and proceeded to read contents of 'Para 8' of 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'P.E.B.' held on 29.01.2024 which thus is reproduced below:-</p> <p style="text-align: center;">“सदर आदेशातील नमुद सुचनेप्रमाणे, या कार्यालयाच्या उपलब्ध अभिलेखाची पडताळणी करण्यात आली. प्रस्तुत प्रकरणी असे निदर्शनास आले की, बहुतांश अंमलदारांनी आंतरजिल्हा बदलीकरिता अर्जांची एकच मुळ प्रत (मुळ अर्ज) या कार्यालयास सादर केली होती. सदर मुळ अर्ज संबंधित जिल्हा कार्यालयांना /घटक कार्यालयांना पाठविण्यात आले होते. त्यामुळे मुळ अर्ज व अर्ज दिनांक याबाबतची माहिती अभिलेखावर उपलब्ध नाही. अंमलदारांनी वचवितच प्रसंगी ०२ प्रतीत अर्ज सादर केलेले आहेत. उपलब्ध अभिलेखावरून कार्यमुक्त करणे बाकी असलेल्या अशा केवळ ५५ अंमलदारांचे अर्जांचे दिनांक मिळून आले आहे. सदर ५५ अर्जांपैकी सर्वात जुना अर्ज २०२० या असून, सन २०२० चे एकूण ०९, सन २०२१ चे १० व सन २०२२ चे ३६ अर्ज आहेत. वर नमुद केल्यानुसार उर्वरित अर्जांच्या प्रती अभिलेखी उपलब्ध नसल्याने, त्यांचे अर्ज/अर्ज दिनांक या कार्यालयास उपलब्ध नाहीत. अर्ज दिनांकाविषयी पुरेशी माहितीच उपलब्ध नसल्याने, केवळ अर्ज दिनांकाचा निकष लावणे योग्य होणार नसल्याबाबत मंडळाने निर्णय घेतलेला आहे. तथापी २०२० च्या सर्व ९ अर्जांचा बारकाईने विचार करून त्यापैकी ०५ अंमलदारांना सोडण्याचा निर्णय मंडळाने घेतला आहे.”</p> <p>9. (iv) Learned P.O. further emphasized that 'P.E.B.' in its meeting held on 29.01.2024 had taken specific note of the observations made in 'Para 8(ii)' of Order dated 09.01.2024 and acknowledged the fact that there are indeed several 'Police Constables' who were not relieved between March 2022 upto June 2022 though senior to 1897 'Police Constables' who had been relieved by the then 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai. The 'P.E.B.' after deliberations on this issue decided to initially relieve 5 'Police Constables' out of 9 'Police Constables' whose applications had been pending since 2020.</p> <p>9. (v) Learned P.O. thereupon drew attention to the fact that 'P.E.B.' in its meeting held on 29.01.2024 has pertinently observed that in respect of many 'Police Constables' seeking 'Inter District Transfer'; the 'Original Applications' were no longer available on 'Office Files' kept by office of 'Commissioner of Police' Greater</p>

10. The Commissioner of Police Greater Mumbai against the backdrop of the meeting of 'P.E.B.' held on 29.02.2024 is thus informed to take the following course of action:-

10. (i) The 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' in next meeting of 'P.E.B.' to consider and decide about cases of 'Inter District Transfers' of those 'Police Constables' for whom willingness have been conveyed by (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Nashik', (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad', (iii) 'Superintendent of Police, Ahmednagar', (iv) 'Superintendent of Police, Satara' after meeting of 'P.E.B.' was held on 29.01.2024.

10. (ii) The 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' to designate a 'Nodal Officer' to facilitate submission of 'Self-Certified Copy' of the 'Original Application' by those 'Police Constables' whose 'Original Copy' are now not available on 'Office Files' and provide them time of 'Two Weeks'

10. (iii) The 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' to thereupon fix 'Time Schedule' for next round of meetings of 'P.E.B.' with view to implement directions in 'Para 8 (ii)' of Order dated 09.01.2024 to deal with several pending cases of 'Police Constables' who were left out and not relieved during March 2022 to June 2022 to join on 'Inter District Transfer' by then 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'.

Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that 'Transfer Order' dated 31.01.2024 of 'Revenue and Forest Department' has ostensibly been issued for implementation of directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 read with provisions of Section 4(4)(ii) and Section 4(5) of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that Applicant came to be posted as 'Deputy Director Tourism Directorate; Nashik' by 'Transfer Order' dated 28.10.2021 of 'Revenue and Forest Department' and is thus yet to complete 'Normal Tenure' of '3 years' under 'Section 3(1)' of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.</p>

Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon states that post of Applicant which is 'Deputy Director Tourism Directorate; Nashik' is not proposed to be notified under 'Section 22' of 'Representation of Peoples Act, 1951' as that of 'Assistant Returning Officer' for conduct of 'General Election to Lok Sabha 2024.'</p> <p>6. Learned Advocate for Applicant then mentioned that 'Husband' of Applicant is also 'Deputy Collector' and posted in 'Ahmednagar District'.</p> <p>7. Learned Advocate for Applicant in this regard quoted from letter dated 23.01.2024 of 'Divisional Commissioner Nashik' addressed to 'Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue & Forest Department' which mentions in its 'Annexure' the 'Names' and 'Designations' of several officers from cadres of (i) Additional Collector (ii) Deputy Collector and (iii) Tahsildars who are not proposed to be entrusted with work directly related to conduct of 'General Elections to Lok Sabha: 2024'. Further he stated that this 'Annexure' includes names of several 'Deputy Collectors' who have been working for much longer periods than Applicant in Nashik and thus should have been transferred to 'Vacant Post' of 'Deputy Collector, Land Acquisition Officer No.1, Dhule'.</p> <p>8. Learned Advocate for Applicant lastly stated that as per the information available no other 'Deputy Collector' has been posted in place of Applicant as 'Deputy Director Tourism, Directorate Nashik'.</p> <p>9.
