1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that 'Medical Education & Drugs Department' has not issued fresh 'Transfer Order' in respect of Applicant till date although it was so recorded by Hon'ble Bombay High Court in its Judgment dated 07.12.2023 in Writ Petition No. 13930 of 2023.

3. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Judgment of Hon'ble Bombay High Court dated 07.12.2023 in Writ Petition No. 13930 of 2023 records "Since Dr. Thakur was transferred to some other position he had withdrawn his Petition".
