The Applicant has challenged order of appellate authority order dated 11.11.2021 whereby the Appeal was dismissed being barred by limitation.</p> <p>3. The Applicant is serving as clerk on the establishment of Tahasildar Mhada, District Solapur. He was subjected Departmental proceeding and Collector Solapur by order dated 06.03.2017 imposed punishment of withholding of increment of two years without cumulative effect. The Applicant being aggrieved by it appealed before Divisional Commissioner, Pune wherein he specifically stated that he was not served with the copy of order of punishment. In Appeal memo the Applicant has specifically stated that he had no knowledge of punishment order and it is only in the information sought under R.T.I. Act he came to know about the punishment. He was further informed under R.T.I. that Department has no record of services of punishment order.</p> <p>4. The learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that the Applicant was not at all served with impugned order of punishment dated 06.03.2017 and despite raising the ground in appeal memo that he has no knowledge of the order of punishment appellate authority ignored it and dismissed appeal on the ground of limitation.</p>

5. Indeed, the Tribunal by order dated 22.02.2022 directed the Respondents to produce record to show service of punishment in D.E. However, no such record is produced when Reply is tendered.

6. Information sought under R.T.I. by the Applicant reveals that office has not served the punishment order upon the Applicant. It is on the basis of information sought under R.T.I. the Applicant came to know about the punishment and thereafter filed appeal before Divisional Commissioner, Pune on 22.07.2020. This being the factual position the appeal could not have been dismissed on the point of limitation. When the Applicant was not served with the punishment order the question of starting of limitation did not survive. Despite the specific ground raised by the Applicant in appeal memo Divisional Commissioner, Pune ~~turning~~ <sup>turning</sup> blind eye to the contention and dismissed the appeal stating that it is barred by limitation which shows non application of mind.

7. In view of above, Divisional Commissioner, Pune ought to have decided the issue of limitation and then should have ~~facilitate~~ <sup>facilitate</sup> to decide appeal on its own merit. Impugned order is therefore liable to be quashed.

8. In so far as limitation is concerned delay ought to be condoned since there was no communication of punishment order to the Applicant. We therefore condone the delay caused in appeal filed before Divisional Commissioner, Pune and direct the Divisional Commissioner, Pune to decide appeal on its own merit.

9. For the aforesaid reason order dated 11.11.2021 is quashed and set aside and matter is remanded back to Divisional Commissioner, Pune. He is directed to decide the appeal within two months from today on merit and the decision as the case may, shall be communicated to the Applicant.

10. O.A. is accordingly disposed of with no order as to costs.

The Applicant was subjected to D.E. by charge sheet dated 02.01.2016 for alleged misconduct. The Enquiry Officer has submitted the report on 20.07.2017 to the Government but thereafter no further steps were taken and it is still pending with the Government.</li> <li>4. 


