- 5. Learned PO based on information from officer present on behalf of Urban Development Department alongwith 'File Notings' states that reason for transfer of Applicant from post of 'Municipal Commissioner; Ichalkaranji Municipal Corporation, District Kolhapur' was the letter written by 'MLA' of '279 Ichalkaranji Legislative Assembly Constituency' on 01.03.2024 to 'Hon'ble Chief Minister Government of Maharashtra'.
- 6. Learned PO further states that on letter of 'MLA' of '279 Ichalkaranji Legislative Assembly Constituency' written on 01.03.2024; certain directions had been given to 'Principal Secretary Urban Development Department by 'Hon'ble Chief Minister Government of Maharashtra'. So factual position about 'Applicant' and 'Respondent No.2' was submitted and further orders sought from 'Hon'ble Chief Minister Government of Maharashtra' who is both 'Competent Transferring Authority' as well as next 'Superior Transferring Authority' under 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.
- 7 The 'Hon'ble Chief Minister Government of Maharashtra' as per 'File Notings' submitted on 30.05.2024 had directed on 11.06.2024 that Respondent No.2 be posted as 'Municipal Commissioner Ichalkaranji Municipal Corporation, District Kolhapur' and accordingly 'Transfer Order' dated 12.06.2024 of Applicant and Respondent No.2 have been issued by Urban Development Department.
- 8. The transfer of Respondent No.2 to post held by Applicant as 'Municipal Commissioner, Ichalkaranji Municipal Corporation, District Kolhapur' is without any recommendation of 'CSB' of Urban Development Department. Further, it is pertinent to note that 'Transfer Order' dated 12.06.2024 of Urban Development Department came to be issued

notwithstanding the fact that both Applicant and Respondent No.2 had not completed 'Normal Tenures' of 3 Years under 'Section 3 (1)' and yet they have been transferred without recording of any 'Special Reasons' or 'Exceptional Circumstances' as required to be done in exercise of 'Statutory Powers' under 'Section 4(4)' and 'Section 4(5)' by the 'Competent Transfer Authority' and next 'Superior Transfer Authority'. Hence the 'Transfer Order' dated 12.06.2024 of Urban Development Department of both Applicant and Respondent No.2 'prima facie' have been issued in gross contravention of letter and spirit of 'Section 4(4)' and 'Section 4(5)' of the 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'. The guidelines laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in landmark Judgment of 'T.S.R. Subramaniam V/s. The Union of India' dated 13.08.2013 have also not been observed besides several 'Judicial Observations' of 'Hon'ble Bombay High Court' have been side stepped to exercise 'Statutory Powers' under 'Section 4(4)' and 'Section 4(5)' 'Competent Transfer Authority' and next 'Superior Transfer Authority'. Hence at this stage 'Balance of Convenience' lies with Applicant for grant of 'Interim Relief'.

9. The Applicant is therefore permitted to continue to hold post of 'Municipal Commissioner, Ichalkaranji Municipal Corporation, District Kolhapur'. Further; if 'Respondent No.2' has been relieved as per Transfer Order dated 12.06.2024 of Urban Development Department, she may choose to join back on earlier post of 'Joint Commissioner, (District Administration Officer, Group-A) in the office of 'District Collector Satara'.

Tribunal's orders

- 10. The grant of 'Interim Relief' to Applicant be conveyed immediately by learned PO to 'Principal Secretary, Urban Development Department'.
- 11. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 12. Issue notice before admission returnable on 11.07.2024.
- 13. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

No.547/2024. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that Applicant had earlier filed O.A. No.1081/2023

regarding his 'Transfer' from post of 'R.F.O. Kankavali, Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg' for which 'Interim Relief' was granted to Applicant on 24.08.2023.

4. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that the Applicant was placed under 'Suspension' by the 'Deputy

Learned Advocate for Applicant states that the Applicant was placed under 'Suspension' by the 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg' on 16.04.2024 under the erroneous believe that such 'Statutory Power' had been vested upon by 'Revenue & Forest Department G.R. dated 01.01.2021'. The 'Revenue & Forest Department G.R. dated 01.01.2021' relates to various authorities of 'Forest Department' who have been designated as 'Heads of Department' as under 'Rule 9(22)' of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (General Conditions of Service), Rules, 1981'. Therefore Order dated

16.04.2024 of 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg' about 'Suspension' of Applicant is patently bad in law as under provisions of 'Rule 4(1)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979'.

- 5. Learned P.O. emphasized that Applicant has been placed under 'Suspension' by Order dated 16.04.2024 of 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg' in exercise of 'Statutory Powers' delegated to 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg' as per 'Revenue & Forest Department G.R. dated 01.01.2021'.
- 6. Learned P.O. then produces copy of 'Affidavit-in-Reply' which had been filed by 'Principal Secretary, Revenue and Forest Department' in O.A. No.179/2021 on 05.08.2022 based on 'Revenue & Forest Department G.R. dated 01.01.2021' to justify correctness of the order of 'Suspension' which had been passed by 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial) Thane'.
- 7. Learned P.O. also states that there are two other 'Judgments' based on same aspects viz. (a) O.A. No.820/2022 dated 24.11.2022 and (b) O.A. No.237/2023 dated 03.07.2023.
- 8. Learned P.O. emphasizes that these 'Judgments' have not been challenged by concerned Applicants and therefore holds grounds and becomes applicable to the present case of Applicant who has filed O.A. No.547/2024.
- 9. The contentions of learned Advocate for Applicant and learned P.O. can be considered in due course; but it is imperative at this stage to refer back to 'Statutory Powers' relating to 'Suspension' of 'Government Servants' under 'Rule 4(1)(a)' of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979' which reads as follows:-
 - 4. Suspension (1) The appointing authority or any authority to which the appointing authority is subordinate or the disciplinary authority or any other authority empowered in that behalf by the Governor by general or special order may place a Government servant under suspension-

Tribunal's orders

The plain reading of 'Rule 4(1)(a) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979' makes it apparent that such 'Statutory Powers' are specifically vested with only 'Appointing Authority' or any 'Authority Superior' to 'Appointing Authority' or 'Disciplinary Authority' or such 'Other Authority' who is empowered in that behalf by 'General Order' or 'Special Order'. Hence declaration of certain 'Senior Officers' of 'Forest Department' as 'Heads of Department' under 'Rule 9(22)' of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (General Conditions of Service), Rules, 1981' does not 'ipso-facto' mean that they all stand empowered under 'Rule 4(1)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979'.

- The 'Principal Secretary, Revenue and Forest Department' to thus informed to diligently peruse provisions of 'Rule 4(1)(a)' of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979'; notwithstanding earlier 'Affidavits-in-Reply' that have been filed in O.A. No.1081/2023 or O.A. No.820/2022 or O.A. No.237/2023, so as to arrive at an informed conclusion as to whether action taken by 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg' to place Applicant under 'Suspension' on 16.04.2024 can be sustained in eyes of law and if not whether 'Forest Department' would choose to take remedial course of action under 'Rule 5(a)' read with 'Rule 5(c)' of the 'Maharashtra Civil Services (General Conditions of Service), Rules, 1981' to revoke order of 'Suspension' of Applicant passed on 16.04.2024 by 'Deputy Conservator of Forest, Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg'; so that accordingly prayers of 'Interim Relief' which have been kept open can be heard on 20.06.2024.
- 11. 'Interim Relief' granted in O.A. No.1081/2023 about 'Transfer' of Applicant from post of 'R.F.O. Kankavali (Territorial)' Sawantwadi Forest Division, District Sindhudurg' to be continued but in state of redundancy till further decision is taken about grant of 'Interim Relief' in O.A. No.547/2024.
