- 1. Heard Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B. K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The Applicant has challenged order dated 18.01.2022 issued by the Collector. He is particularly aggrieved by 1st clause of the order wherein it is stated that the Applicant is deemed to be suspended w.e.f. 17.05.2015 and in 3rd clause it is stated that period from 17.05.2015 to 12.08.2021 will also be treated as suspension period. Then again in clause 5-the Collector further stated that whether the period from 17.05.2015 to 12.08.2021 will be considered as a duty period or otherwise will be decided after final decision in D.E.
- 3. During the course of hearing, it is transpired that Applicant has already availed remedy of filing appeal before the Divisional Commissioner, Pune who decided the appeal on 15.06.2022 and some extent interfered with the order passed by the Collector.
- that the period from 17.05.2015 to 20.07.2015 is required to be considered as suspension period and the period from 21.07.2015 to 12.08.2021 has to be treated as a period of dismissal (out of service period) and after the said decision only, the Applicant can file an appeal. The Commissioner thus holds that the appeal is premature but at the same time, the Commissioner also directed to Collector to take the decision abut one earlier period of suspension from 18.08.2010 to 22.10.2010.

Tribunal's orders

- 5. Thus, in view of the order passed by the Commissioner, the Collector, Kolhapur was required to pass further order. However, till date he has not passed any such order.
- 6. Thus, the grievance raised by the Applicant that to much extent is addressed by the Commissioner in his appellate order and directed the Collector to take requisite steps in light of observations made by him.
- 7. In view of above, O.A. deserves to be disposed of with suitable directions to the Respondents.
- 8. Learned Counsel for the Applicant has pointed out that before taking any such decision, the Collector is required to follow Rule 70 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Joining Time, Foreign Service, and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal) Rules, 1981 (herein after referred to as 'Rules 1981') which *inter-alia* provides procedure to follow while determining the issue of entitlement of a Government servant for pay and allowances of out of service period where he is reinstated in service. In this behalf, he referred to Circular dated 12.06.1986 issued by the Government.
- 9. Since now it is for the Collector, Kolhapur to take appropriate decision in the matter. It would not be appropriate to make any observation by this Tribunal. All that can be said that the Collector, Kolhapur is required to act upon the order passed by the Commissioner dated 15.06.2022 and in observance of Rule 70 of 'Rules 1981' shall pass appropriate order.
- 10. In view of above, O.A. is disposed of with direction to Respondent- Collector, Kolhapur to pass appropriate order in the light of observation made above within two months from today.
- 11. No order as to costs.

ORDER

- 1. The applicant, who aspires to the post of Deputy Director of Town Planning, Maharashtra Town Planning and Valuation Service, Group-A, challenges the list of non-eligible candidates qua the applicant, is to be quashed and set aside.
- 2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is shown as disqualified on the ground that he did not upload the necessary educational qualification and experience certificate as per clause 11.2.4 of the advertisement dated 28.1.2022, (Page 20). Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the interviews for the said post is fixed today and tomorrow. Learned counsel for the applicant further states that



the applicant has submitted on-line application on 21.2.2022 and the applicant came to know about his disqualification on 7.10.2022 and the interviews for the same is going to held today and tomorrow, i.e. on 13.10.2022 and 14.10.2022. Learned counsel for the applicant therefore prays that as he has already uploaded the necessary Certificates and but the same could not have been uploaded due to some technical flaw, the applicant should be allowed to appear for the interview.

- 3. Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that immediately on 7.10.2022, the applicant sent email informing the Respondents that he possessed the necessary educational qualification and experience Certificate and they were sent again by attaching the same to the email. The Respondents informed the applicant that his email is forwarded for consideration to the concerned department. Again the applicant sent email to the Respondents on 12.10.2022, pointing out the same information and facts. Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant has filed two applications for two separate posts advertised by the Respondents. While he is aggrieved for his disqualification for interview for one post as the Certificates are not uploaded, but the application in respect of the second post is uploaded and properly accepted. Learned counsel for the applicant further pointed out the list of non-eligible candidates which was published on 6.10.2022, in which there are two persons like him who are held disqualified for want of uploading of the necessary documents/certificates along with the application.
- 4. Learned P.O, opposes the Original Application and on instructions from Smt Dhanashree S. Kirtane, Section Officer, in the office of M.P.S.C, submits that nearly 82 applications are received by M.P.S.C and the documents/Certificates of all the 82

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applicants were received except the documents/Certificates of the present applicant, as the applicant has not uploaded the necessary Certificates required to ascertain the eligibility and he is rightly disqualified from the process of selection.

- 5. It appears from clause 11.2.4 of the advertisement, that unless the documents are uploaded the application cannot be presented. However, in the present case, the application was not only presented, but accepted by the Computer and the payment against the said application was also accepted by M.P.S.C. Under such circumstanced, the possibility of technical flaw cannot be overruled. Therefore, in all fairness, we are of the view that the interim relief as prayed for is to be granted in favour of the applicant.
- 6. In view of the above, we direct the Respondent, M.P.S.C to allow the applicant to appear for the interview for the post of Deputy Director of Town Planning, Maharashtra Town Planning and Valuation Service, Group-A, going to be held on 13.10.2022 and 14.10.2022. The applicant is directed to produce all the necessary documents and Certificates at the time of interview. The interim relief granted will be subject to the outcome of the Original Application.
- 7. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 8. Issue notice before admission returnable on 10.11.2022.
- 9. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is

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allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

- 10. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
