On the same day Respondents issue recovery notice stating that sum of Rs.1,55,772/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Five Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Two Only) is due against interest of Home Loan advance and Rs.1,63,592/- (Rupees One Lakh Sixty Three Thousand Five Hundred and Ninety Two Only) against loan obtained from Kokan Prant Sahakari Bank Ltd.
- 3. The Applicant sought interim relief to stay the recovery.
- 4. Insofar as recovery of interest of Rs.1,55,772/-against Home Loan advance is concerned the Applicant is bound to pay the same and it can be recovered from Gratuity. However, as regard recovery of Rs.1,63,592/-in respect of loan obtained from Kokan Prant Sahakari Bank Ltd *prima-faice* it cannot be recovered from Gratuity. The Society from whom loan is taken is required to take further legal course for the recovery. *Prima-faice* such recovery from retiral benefits is not permissible. Hence, recovery of Rs.1,63,592/- towards Society loan interim relief to stay the recovery to that extent is granted.
- 5. Since, issue involved in the matter is very short it can be disposed of after obtaining short Affidavit of the Respondent.
- 6. One week time is granted to file Affidavit-in-Reply.
