The order of 'District Collector, Kolhapur' dated 12.12.2023 mentions that no applications had been received from any of the Respondent Nos.3, 4 & 5 to be posted on 'Vacant Posts' in office of 'District Collector, Kolhapur' at the time of 'General Transfer: 2023'. Hence, as no applications were available on record in office of 'District Collector, Kolhapur'; they could not have been considered as per directions given on 28.11.2023.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant however contended these reasons cited in order passed by 'District Collector, Kolhapur' on 12.12.2023. She referred to 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.' wherein it has been recorded that while 'Respondent No.3' had given options only for office of 'District Collector, Kolhapur'; 'Respondent No.4' had given options not only for office 'District Collector, Kolhapur' but also 'Tahsil Offices Panhala, Hatkanangale & Kagal' and Respondent No.5 had also given options not only for office of 'District Collector Kolhapur, but also 'Tahsil Offices Kagal, Panhala, Hatkanangale'. Subsequently they were all transferred to available posts of 'Awal Karkoon in 'Tahsil Office Panhala' at the time of 'General Transfer: 2023'. She further contended that it</p>

	<p>was therefore evident that 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.' were not referred to by 'District Collector Kolhapur' before passing Order on 12.12.2023 which affirmatively records otherwise; that no such Applications had been received from Respondent Nos.3,4 & 5 at the time of 'General Transfer 2023'. Further in 'Para 4' it also been recorded that Respondent Nos.3, 4 & 5 have now given letters to 'District Collector, Kolhapur' requesting that they should not be transferred from their present posts of 'Awal Karkoon' in 'Tahsil Office - Panhala'.</p> <p>4. The order of 'District Collector, Kolhapur' dated 12.12.2023 even if it has not recorded some facts correctly as per 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.'; it is not required to be interfered with; as it is not challenged in this O.A.
