ORAL ORDER :

Hear S/shri Ajay Deshpande and Shri C.V. Dharurkar, learned counsel for the applicants and Shri M.S. Mahajan, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

2. This Original Application is filed seeking following main and interim relief :-

"10. RELIEF (S) SOUGHT:

- A) This Original Application may kindly be allowed.
- By passing appropriate order or direction the R.1 B] State Government may kindly be directed to withdraw the requisition sent by it to the R.2 for way selection and appointments by of promotions to the vacant posts of I.A.S and not to process the same until a suitable decision is taken, in pursuance to the Judgment and order dated 28.04.2022 [Annexure-A.6] passed by the Hon'ble Single Judge of the Madras High Court in Writ Petition No. 17643/2012, in response to the representations [Annexure-A.4] filed by the Applicant/s.

11. INTERIM RELIEFS, IF ANY PRAYED FOR:

C) During hearing and final disposal of the present Original Application, the R.2 Commission may kindly be directed to refrain from making

recommendations for appointments to vacant posts of I.A.S. by promotion.

- D) Ad interim relief in terms of Prayer Clause [C] may kindly be granted.
- El Any other appropriate order or relief in the interest of justice may kindly be passed."

3. The applicant no. 1 is an Association, which is registered Organization working for espousing the cause of employees working under the State Development Service. The applicant nos. 2 to 5 are the Officers under Development Services as contemplated in Maharashtra Development Service (Constitution, Classification and Recruitment)(Amendment) Rules, 1973 (Annex. A-3).

4. As per Indian Administrative Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 laid down by the Central Government in tune with section 3 of the All India Service Act, 1951, 33% posts of the I.A.S. posts are reserved to be filled in from the State Civil Service by promotion and out of these 33 %, 15% posts are reserved for Services other than the State Civil Service, such as M.D.S. and others in terms of rule 9(1) read with rule 8(2) of the Indian Administrative Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1954.

5. It is contended that despite being eligible to be considered for I.A.S. post by promotion, the applicant organization members are made to remain complacent with the limited 15% quota out of 33% posts that are open for promotion. The Members of the State Services other than

Revenue Department are made to undergo examination for being considered for promotion, whereas the members from the Revenue Department are considered for promotion directly based on their performance in service and their ACRs. No examination is prescribed for the Members from Revenue Department, who stake their claims for IAS promotion.

6. The applicant 1 Association has made representations on 3.3.2020, 10.2.2020 and 3.3.2023 (Annex. A-4 collectively) to the Hon'ble chief Minister praying to treat them at par with Revenue Department employees and give them liberty to compete for promotion for IAS for 33% quota, but in vain.

7. Applicants have placed reliance on the decision dated 28.4.2022 passed by the Single Judge of Hon'ble Madras High Court in W.P. No. 17643/2012 (Annex. A-5), wherein in similar situation following order is passed :-

"24. Considering the totality of the circumstances, the following directions are issued to the State Government:-

(i) The Government shall consider forming of Tamil Nadu Administrative Service including all the Departments connected to the Revenue and General Administration, Implementation of State policies for development in General as has been done by the Kerala Government.

(ii) The Government shall consider taking steps

to treat all the State Level Officers alike and provide equal opportunity to them by making appropriate recommendation to the Central

Government to bring them into Administrative Service for effective Administration.

(iii) The State Government shall constitute a Committee for the purpose of identifying the posts, which can be brought under the definition of Deputy Collector as done in G.O.(4D) No.12, Public (Special-A) Department, dated 26.08.2005.

We hope that the process will be initiated by the State Government within a period of six months."

8. The said judgment and order is confirmed by the Division Bench of Madrad High Court in Letters Patent Appeal No. WA No. 1583, 1584, 1600 and 1972/2022 and CMP No. 10522, 10532, 10643 and 14438/2022 by order dated 15.9.2022 (Annex. A-6).

9. In view of above, it is contended that if the impugned requisition sent by the State Government i.e. respondent no. 1 to respondent no. 2 is considered, irreparable loss and great prejudice is likely to be caused to the applicants' interest. The learned counsel for the applicants submitted that requisition of the State Government is likely to be considered in the meeting of the Committee headed by learned Chairman of UPSC i.e. respondent no. 2 tomorrow i.e. on 14.6.2023. Hence the applicants prayed for grant of interim relief.

10. The learned Chief Presenting Officer opposed the submissions raised on behalf of the applicants. According to him, the issue of jurisdiction is serious as direction is sought against respondent no. 2 – UPSC, which is connected with the

Government of India and not the State Government. He seeks time to file affidavit in reply of the respondents, if notices are issued to them.

11. After having considered the O.A. together with the documents on record and rival submissions, it is seen that the applicants are seeking directions against the respondent no. 2 UPSC to refrain from making recommendations for appointment to the vacant posts of IAS by promotion by considering the requisition made by respondent no. 1 in that regard. The applicants are agitating the reliefs on the basis of unequal treatment for Revenue Department Officers on one hand and other officers of State Services including MDS officers on the other hand. Admittedly, whole process of promotion to the posts of IAS cadre is governed by the provisions of rule 8 and 9 of the Indian Administrative Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1954.

12. It is true that the applicants stated to have made representations in this regard twice in the year 2020 and one representation in 2023 to the Hon'ble Chief Minister. There is mention of the decision dated 15.9.2022 in Writ Appeal No. 1600/2022 of Hon'ble Madras High Court in the representation made by the applicants on 3.3.2023 (Annex. A-4 collectively).

13. The matter pertains to policy decision. Rules are already on record in respect of promotion to the post of IAS from State Civil Services and other than State Civil Services such as Maharashtra Development Services. The rules are not

under challenge. Contravention of rules is not alleged. Unequal treatment as regards promotion to the post of IAS and unequal distribution of quota is challenged. Moreover, subject matter of litigation is based on All India Administrative Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 and moreover specific directions are sought against respondent no. 2 i.e. UPSC by way of interim relief. The applicants are stating that up to recommendation part subject matter belongs to and within the jurisdiction of the State Government. Prima-facie reading of rules 8 & 9 of Indian Administrative Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1954 would show that ultimately decision is to be taken by the Central Government.

14. In view of that the issue of jurisdiction is required to be considered by taking into consideration the contentions to be raised by the respondents. Moreover, the applicants are seeking relief on the basis of judgment of Hon'ble Madras High Court as mentioned above. The said aspect is required to be considered, which can be considered at the time of hearing after taking into consideration the affidavit in reply of the respondents.

15. In view of above in our considered opinion, no primafacie case is made out and the balance of convenience also does not lie in favour of the applicant for interim relief. Hence this is not a fit case to grant the interim relief. Hence the prayer for interim relief is rejected.

16. Issue notice to respondents, returnable on 27.6.2023.The issue of jurisdiction is kept open.

17. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

18. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

19. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

20. The service may be done by hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgment be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry before due date. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.

21. S.O. to 27.6.2023.

22. Steno copy and Hamdast is allowed to both parties.

2. This Misc. Application seeking the relief to sue jointly is allowed, subject to payment of court fee stamps, if not paid., for the reasons stated in the application as the applicants belong to same cadre of Maharashtra Development Services (for short M.D.S.) and are agitating one and the same grievance. However, the office objection of jurisdiction is kept open as the applicants are seeking relief against respondent no. 2 – the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi – which authority is concerned with the Government of India and said aspect of jurisdiction can be considered in detailed only at the time of hearing of the O.A.

4. Accompanying O.A. be registered and numbered, after removal of office objections, if any. The present M.A. stands disposed of accordingly without any order as to costs.
