The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the precedents reveal that the officer of the rank of Deputy Labour Commissioner had been assigned the post of Chairman of Mathadi and Unprotected Labour Board. The learned counsel taking me through the provisions of the Maharashtra Mathadi, Hamal and Other Manual Workers (Regulation of Employment and Welfare) Act, 1969 brought to my notice how the Board is constituted and how

the Chairman is nominated. The learned counsel further submitted that the person namely Shri Raut was earlier holding the post of Chairman of Aurangabad Mathadi and Unprotected Labour Board and he is very well at Aurangabad and in such circumstances, there was no rational in assigning the additional charge of the said post to the applicant, who is working as Assistant Labour Commissioner. The learned counsel submitted that with some ulterior motive the applicant has been given the additional charge of the said post in addition to his charge of regular post. The learned counsel submitted that the applicant has not yet taken over the additional charge of the post of President, Aurangabad Mathadi and Unprotected Labour Board and it is still continued with the earlier President. The learned counsel in the circumstances prayed for staying the effect and operation of the impugned order temporarily till the affidavit in reply is filed by the respondents.

3. Shri M.S. Mahajan, learned Chief Presenting Officer submitted that primarily there seems no reason for staying the impugned order, since

ordinarily an officer is called to hold in addition to his regular duty the additional charge of other post if contingency so arises. The learned C.P.O. submitted that from the impugned order it reveals that for certain reasons charge has been withdrawn from the earlier person and the applicant is asked to hold the said responsibility. The learned C.P.O. submitted that within one week he will file affidavit in reply so that all the necessary material will come on record. The learned C.P.O. further submitted that he is not having any objection in keeping the option of interim relief open.
