- All Eight Applicants have filed this two M.As. 2. The eight Applicants are in Police service on the post of Constable and Head Constable below the rank of P.S.I.. They desire to be P.S.I.. They all have appeared for Departmental Competitive Examination Limited (L.D.C.E.) of 2016. They all have secured marks below 230. It is submitted by the learned Advocate for the Applicants that for the examination of 2016, 828 post for P.S.I. were available and those all post were filed. Original 828 post + 154 and 636 i.e. 790 additional post of P.S.I. were filled in the year 2016 by virtue of examination. In the year 2017 another L.D.C.E. examination was conducted and all eight candidates had appeared for 2017 examination. However, they did not pass the examination and therefore they were not considered as eligible for the post of P.S.I.

- Police Constables have filed Application before the Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal and Aurangabad Bench has stayed on 18.10.2019 to filling the post of 636 candidates.
