therefore, in these circumstances, there is no need to extend the interim relief in favour of the Applicant.

7. Learned P.O. has produced the copy of the letter dated 12.09.2018 and the same is taken on record.

8. Considering the submission of the learned P.O, it reveals that the practice followed by the Respondents about issuance of transfer orders by the Government, the Respondent No.2 – Commissioner used to issue movement order relieving the concerned Officer who is under transfer in implementation of the transfer order. In the instant case, the Government issued the order dated 30th August, 2018 and thereby transferred and posted Respondent No.3 at Thane Code No.80.

9. Thereafter, this Tribunal has passed the order dated 7.9.2018 and directed the Respondents not to issue order in respect of Shri Wazarkar as regards his posting at Thane Code No.80.

9. In view of the fact that transfer order of Respondent No.3 has already been issued on 30th August, 2018, in my opinion, it is just and proper to direct Respondent No.2 not to implement the said order dated 30.08.2018 and to issue movement order till next date.

10. Accordingly, Respondent No.2 is directed not to implement the order dated 30.08.2018 till next date.

5. In view that finalization of seniority has been delayed inordinately, the issue ought not be left being dealt with casually and let the finalization of seniority take precedence, because adhocism appears to be the rule in promotions instead of regular promotion.

6. In the event a case of compelling urgency is made out, requirement of such leave to order of ad hoc promotions can be considered, after such leave is sought by making application.

7. Hence, State shall not issue any order of ad hoc promotion unless seniority list is finalized without express leave of this Tribunal.

9. Liberty to file rejoinder.
