1. Shri N.W. Sawant, Shri G.A. Bandiwadekar, Shri M.D. Lonkar, learned Advocates for Applicants are present. Shri S.S. Dere, learned Advocates for Applicant is present through Video-Conference. Shri A.J. Chougule, Smt. K.S. Gaikwad & Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officers for Respondents are present.

2. Learned P.O. based on instructions from 'D.C.P. (HQ-2) in office of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' who is personally present emphasizes that last remaining '33 Applicants' in these 'Group of O.A. Nos.26 & Ors.' cannot be relieved on account of large number of 'Vacant Posts' of 'Police Constables' and ensuing 'General Elections Maharashtra Legislative Assembly: 2024'.
3. Learned Advocates for Applicant insist that there could be no rationale for last remaining '33 Applicants' not to be relieved forthwith by 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' to join other 'Police Establishments' on 'Inter District Transfers'; as large number of 'Vacant Posts' which had once even exceeded '10000 Police Constables' primarily due to unforeseen delays in organizing recruitment drives during intervening period of 'COVID Pandemic'; have now substantially reduced especially after more than '7500 Police Constables' who had completed 'Training Programme' in 'PTCs' have reported on 31.08.2024 and subsequently stand deployed by 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'.
4. The 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' had been given more than adequate opportunity in the recent past especially after 31.07.2024 to forthwith redress grievances of remaining '59 Applicants' in this 'Group of O.A. No.26/2022 & Others'.
5. The 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' has appreciably relieved upto 31.07.2024 most of the 'Applicants' who had sought 'Inter District Transfer' to other 'Police Establishments' by filing this batch of 'O.A. No.26/2022 & Others' inspite of large number vacancies of more than '10000 Police Constables'. However, as more than '7500 Police Constables' have now joined in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' after '31.08.2024' and subsequently have been deployed for ensuing 'General Election of Maharashtra Legislative Assembly: 2024'; the subsistence of 'Vacant Posts' of 'Police Constables' even if large cannot now be cited as justiciable grounds for not relieving the last remaining '33 Applicants' in this 'Group of O.A. No.26/2022 & Others'.

The tenuous grounds cited above by learned P.O. based on instructions from 'DCP (HQ-2)' in office of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' are no longer acceptable; as 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' had commendably led his entire team to discharge all responsibilities to ensure successful conduct of 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024' when there were 'Vacant Posts' of more than 10000 'Police Constables' & 'Police Constable Drivers' out of total 43,614 'Sanctioned Posts' in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'.</p> <p>7. The last remaining 33 Applicants had also applied long back for 'Inter District Transfer' on grounds of 'Personal Hardships' which are not really different from many others who have since been relieved by 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' to join on 'Inter District Transfer' to other 'Police Establishments'. Hence, as last remaining '33 Applicants' who constitute just about 0.075% of total '43,614 Sanctioned Posts' of 'Police Constables' & 'Police Constable Drivers' in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'; cannot even by imagination cause impediment in overall 'Maintenance of Law & Order' or ensuring 'Security Protocols' etc. during conduct of 'General Elections Maharashtra Legislative Assembly: 2024' the 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' was earnestly nudged recently on 04.10.2024 to forthwith relieve last remaining '33 Applicants'; but surprisingly today it is vehemently contended by 'DCP (HQ-2)' in office of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' that they would be able to relieve the last remaining '33 Applicants' only after completion of 'General Election of Maharashtra Legislative Assembly: 2024'.</p>

The 'PEB' was expected to consider with some degree of compassion in its last meeting held on 30.09.2024 these finer aspects of 'Service Matters' relating to last remaining '33 Applicants' who have served in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' at the 'Bottom of Pyramid'. Hence in the situation which has now evolved due to unwillingness on part 'PEB' in its meeting held on 30.09.2024 to not consider the cases of last remaining '33 Applicants'; the threshold of judicial perseverance stands crossed and appropriate time has arrived to impose on 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' this 'Specific Order' passed in 'Judicial Proceedings' under 'Section 19' read with 'Section 30' of 'The Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985' to direct that the last remaining '33 Applicants' be relieved without recommendation of 'PEB'.

9. The last remaining '33 Applicants' in this batch of 'O.A. Nos.26/2022 & Others' shall be relieved by 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' within 'One Week' of uploading of this 'Specific Order' dated 14.10.2024 in 'Group of O.A. Nos.26/2022 & Others'.
