The letter of 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' dated 24.09.2023 by way of 'Annexure' had also indicated the 'Number of Posts' of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicles' which would be available for 'General Transfers: 2023' in the 52 Subordinate Offices under 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai'.	
	3. Learned Advocate for Applicant then referred to another letter of the 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' dated 11.10.2023 by which these 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicle' were subsequently instructed to submit supportive documents in relation

Learned Advocate for the Applicant thereupon stated it is evident from Transfer Order dated 06.11.2023 that postings of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicles' have been effected by using 'Computerized Transfer System'. The exercise of 'General Transfer: 2023' had been undertaken belatedly from 24.09.2023 to 06.11.2023. He also states that 'C.S.B.' constituted by 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' was not as per guidelines in GAD GR dated 31.01.2014. Further the 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' was not 'Competent Transferring Authority' to have unilaterally approved such *de-facto* 'Mid Term' postings of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicle' without obtaining prior approval of next 'Superior Transferring Authority' who is the 'Minster-in-Charge' of 'Transport Department'.

5. Learned P.O. then states that the postings of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicles' have been effected by 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' for the first time using 'Computerized Transfer System' for greater transparency and after preparation of 'SOP' as per approval granted by Home Department (Transport) GR dated 28.06.2023 The provisions of law under 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' have been observed while using the 'Computerized Transfer System'. The recommendations of 'C.S.B.' were submitted to 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' by following guidelines in G.A.D. G.R. dated 09.04.2018. She therefore stated that no case of 'Interim Relief' has been made out by the Applicants.

6. The Order' dated 06.11.2023 issued by of 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' in respect of the Applicants who are 'Assistant Inspectors of Motor Vehicles' itself mentions that it has been done by using 'Computerized Transfer System'. The 'Computerized Transfer System' which has been used for first time to transfer 'Assistant Inspectors of Motor Vehicle' has probably been developed in-house by the office of 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai'. The report submitted by 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' to 'Principal Secretary (Transport), Home Department, on 20.10.2023 states that since transfers of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicles' who were due for 'General Transfers: 2023' were being done after the 31 st May, 2023; it requires <i>'ex-post facto'</i> approval of 'Hon'ble Chief Minister of Maharashtra State' who is also 'Minister-in-Charge' of the 'Transport Department'. Hence it is evident that though 'Transport Commissioner Mumbai' belatedly sought to effect 'General Transfers: 2023' of 'Assistant Inspectors of Motor Vehicles'; they were admittedly 'Mid-Term' transfers under Section (4)(ii) and 4(5) of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'. Further if these transfers of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicles' are to be categorized as per law to be 'Mid-Term' transfers; then requisite conditions required to be fulfilled such as recording of 'Special Reasons' and 'Exceptional Circumstances'; must happen and these could not have just been simply completion of 'Normal Tenure' of 3 Years because law has not only distinguished the 'Criteria for Transfers' and but also differentiated the 'Levels of Competence'. Further, the members of 'C.S.B.' who were required to collectively apply their minds while submitting recommendations; now seem to have got substituted by the inanimate 'Computerized Transfer System'. The members of 'C.S.B.' it appears have rather limited role now of just to 'Sign Printouts' generated by algorithms embedded in the implementation of 'Computerized Transfer System'. Thus, many questions relating to the 'Computerized	
	Transfer System' are bound to arise as its lies at the intersection of 'Statute' and 'Technology'. Nonetheless; the initiative of 'Transport Commissioner, Mumbai' to devise 'Computerized Transfer System' for 'General Transfer: 2023' of 'Assistant Inspector of Motor Vehicle' is certainly appreciable. The legal validity of the 'Computerized Transfer System' will thus have to be established by the 'Transport Commissioner Mumbai'

The learned Advocate for the Applicant relies on the Permanency Certificate dated 20.02.2022 (Page No.83) issued by Civil Surgeon, General Hospital, Aurangabad where the name of Applicant appears along with other Nurses and her designation is shown as Nurse Psychiatric and it is mentioned that the appointment as Nurse Psychiatric is the date of joining as 10.10.1997.

4. We cannot accept this Permanency Certificate dated 20.02.2022 of Civil Surgeon, as the settled position of law is that, when a person joins a particular cadre, the seniority in that cadre is to be counted from the Date of Appointment in that cadre. Therefore, at this stage, we refuse to grant 'Interim Relief' that the process of promotion to the post of 'Assistant Matron' be stayed.

At the outset, learned P.O. has submitted that in the order dated 25.09.2018 passed in O.A.No.609/2016 in paragraph 3 it is mentioned that during pendency of O.A. the Applicant, by order 	
	dated 23.06.2017, was promoted as Deputy Commissioner of Police, Motor Transport, Mumbai, Learned P.O. has submitted now the only issue is pendency of grant of deemed date of promotion and by order dated 26.02.2018 the concerned Respondents rejected the claim of the applicant regarding deemed date of promotion on the ground that no junior of the applicant was promoted earlier and the Applicant's case came into consideration in the year 2017.	

Tribunal's orders

4. We have considered the prayers. We have also considered the letter dated 26.02.2018 wherein the State rejected the applicant's claim for grant of deemed date of promotion. It is surprised that this particular letter was not pointed out to the Hon'ble Bombay High Court at the relevant time when the matter was taken up for hearing. It was the duty of both the parties to point out this letter as it gives birth to the new cause of action which was not prayed in the present O.A.

5. Learned Counsel Mr. Bhosle has argued that the copy of letter dated 26.02.2018 was attached to the Writ Petition when the matter was taken up by the Hon'ble Division Bench before the Hon'ble High Court.

6. We consider the statement made by learned Counsel that copy of letter dated 26.02.2018 was attached to the Writ Petition as true. However. when the matter is argued before the Hon'ble High Court it was the duty of the learned Counsel to point out that particular letter to raise the issue or to mention it at the time of arguments. After going through the order dated 20.09.2023 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Writ Petition No.709/2019 wherein the O.A.No.609/2010 was restored to file and the Tribunal was directed to endeavor to disposed of O.A. as early as possible subject to earlier time bound commitments, it transpires that no arguments on this point were advanced as there is no mention of letter dated 26.02.2018

7. In view of above, nothing survives in the O.A. and the same stands disposed of as infructuous. However, we grant liberty to the Applicant to file fresh O.A. for the new cause of action, if any.

2. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant joined the services on 9.1.1996 however her services were not regularized. It was regularized on 18.9.1999. It is submitted that by letter dated 15.2.2019 the Govt. informed that her services is to be considered for regularization from 1996.

3. The OA is drafted in a very clumsy manner. No separate prayer is mentioned. However, after going through the entire OA, Ld. PO submits that the applicant has prayed:

(i) That application of the applicant for Voluntary Retirement is to be accepted and accordingly she should be given pension and pensionary benefits.

(ii) That her leave period from 9.8.2013 to 26.11.2012 and 19.10.2018 to 15.10.2019 is to be regularized.

(iii) That her unpaid salary is to be paid.

4. Ld. PO submits that first leave period is regularized. However, second leave period is not yet decided as there was no separate application filed by the applicant in the department. Ld. PO submits that whatever salary was pending is already paid to the applicant. Ld. PO on instructions submits that applicant is entitled to get pensionary benefits as per rules and for that it is necessary for the applicant to open Pension Account in the Bank and furnish cancelled cheque to the department.

5. In view of the above the applicant is directed to open Pension Account in the Bank and furnish cancelled cheque.

6. At the request of the applicant the matter is adjourned to 16.1.2024. Applicant to follow the directions given otherwise we are going to dismiss the matter.
