3. It is the grievance of the applicant that respondent no.4 is not the competent authority to transfer the applicant. Moreover, the applicant gave three options. As per the option form (Part of Annexure A-2) the applicant gave options for Parali, Dist. Beed, Loha, Dist. Nanded and Selu, Dist. Parbhani. It is the contention of the applicant that he had not given option of Jalna. In view of the

same, according to the applicant the impugned transfer order is not legal and proper. He, therefore, seeks relief of stay to the execution of the impugned transfer order contending that the applicant has not been relieved from his present post.

4. Learned P.O. opposed the submissions made on behalf of the applicant and submitted that the applicant has not produced the full chart of vacancy position on record. The impugned transfer order is legal and proper.

5. Perusal of the impugned transfer order would show that, it is signed by respondent no.4 but it is specifically mentioned that the same is issued in concurrence of the competent transferring authority. The impugned transfer order is also issued on the letter head of the competent transferring authority i.e. Commissioner, Health Service, Mumbai. In this regard, learned P.O. has placed on record communication dated 09-06-2023 which shows that the same is signed by the officers holding the designation of respondent no.2 and respondent no.4. Same is taken on record and marked as document "X" for identification.

6. Learned Advocate for the applicant at this stage also pointed out transfer order dated 09-06-2023 (Annexure A-10). Said transfer order is signed by Chief Administrative Officer, Health Services, Mumbai of the respondent no.2. In the said order also, it is mentioned that same is issued in concurrence of the respondent no.2. Again transfer order is issued on 10-06-2023 (Annexure A-11) which is impugned in the present O.A. Said transfer order is ratified by the respondents by placing on record copy of the minutes dated 09-06-2023. In view of the same, in my considered opinion at this stage it cannot be said that the impugned transfer order is not issued by the competent transferring authority. Despite that, after receipt of the affidavit in reply, on hearing the parties if the things are required to be considered the same will be done at the time of final hearing of the O.A.

7. Another grievance of the applicant is that he has not been given the posting from amongst the 3 options given by the applicant. It is not explained by the applicant why he has given only 3 options. Moreover, total vacancy position is not disclosed

from the documents. In view thereof, if it reveals during the course of hearing that there is any mala fide in issuing impugned transfer order, that can be taken care of at the time of final hearing. Therefore, in my considered opinion it is not a fit case for grant of interim relief. Hence, the prayer for interim relief stands rejected.
