Learned counsel for the applicant submitted 3. that the applicant is quite sure about validity of his certificate and has placed on record the relevant documents in support of his said contention. counsel for the applicant Learned in the circumstances has prayed for direction against the respondents not to fill up one post reserved for O.B.C. Sports Category till decision of the present Original Application.

4. Learned P.O. for the respondents has opposed for grant of any such relief. Learned P.O. submitted that big scam was unearthed pertains to validity certificates issued to the candidates applying for the Sports Category. He, further, submitted that so far as the present applicant is concerned, his sport validity has been cancelled in re-verification and as such the applicant cannot claim appointment on such post. Learned P.O. for the respondents in the circumstances, while seeking time for filing detailed affidavit in reply, has opposed for grant of any interim relief.

The applicants are also intending to place on record some subsequent events and more particularly the directions issued vide letter dated 22.5.2003. The learned counsel for the applicants submits that the final seniority list is published in the month of June, 2023.The learned counsel further submitted that the applicants are already entered in the cadre of Naib Tahsildars, however, their names are not shown in the final seniority list of Naib Tahsildars. Learned counsel further submitted that apart from

that their names are not included in the final seniority list, directions are now issued which may result in reversion of the applicants to the post of Circle Officer. Learned counsel in the circumstances, prayed for allowing the M.A. for amendment and also to grant interim relief, thereby restraining the respondents not to revert the applicants till the decision of the O.A.

3. Shri M.P. Gude, learned Presenting Officer has strongly opposed for allowing such amendment stating that it will change the entire nature of the O.A. Learned P.O. submitted that all such pleadings could have been taken in anticipation by the applicants in their O.A. Now they cannot be permitted to make any such amendment in the O.A.

4. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicants, as well as, the respondents. In the O.A. the applicants have prayed for quashment of the final seniority list of the cadre of Circle Officers published vide Circular dated 20.9.2022, wherein their names are alleged to be shown below their juniors. Now it is the case of the applicants

that after filing of the O.A. provisional seniority list of the cadre of Naib Tahsildars came to be published and since their names were not included therein, they submitted their objections to the said list. It is their further contention that the objections so raised have not been appropriately considered by the respondents and in the final seniority list also the names of the applicants are not included. Learned counsel submits that these facts need to be brought on record since these are in continuation of earlier grievance raised by the applicants. There appears substance in the contention so raised by the Since all these events have occurred applicants. after filing of the O.A. by the applicants, the same could not have been incorporated in the O.A. As stated in the O.A., the applicants are already in the cadre of Naib Tahsildars and have been confirmed on the said post. In such circumstances, if their names are not found first in the provisional seniority list and thereafter in the final seniority list of the cadre of Naib Tahsildars, it cannot be said that applicants cannot bring on record the said circumstances, on the ground that it will change the

nature of O.A. The contents sought to be incorporated and contextual prayers are quite inconsonance with the O.A.

5. Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that in view of letter dated 22.5.2023, applicants apprehend their reversion. Learned counsel, therefore, prayed for interim order against the respondents not to revert the applicants from their present posts of Naib Tahsildars until further orders from this Tribunal.

6. I see substance in the contention so raised and prayer so made. In identical matter this Tribunal has granted such relief to the similarly situated candidates. Hence, I pass the following order: -

<u>O R D E R</u>

(i) The Misc. Application stands allowed.

(ii) The necessary amendment be carried out in the O.A. within two weeks from today and copy of amended O.A. be supplied to other side.
