In O.A.No.343/2020, the Applicant has tendered letter dated 15.10.2018 issued by the Integrated Child Commissioner, No.2-Respondent Development Department addressed to Respondent No.1 -Human and Child Development Principal Secretary, Department stating that he has received the proposal to grant medical leave of 530 days for the period from 16.06.2015 to 26.11.2016. As per letter dated 15.10.2018 at the end on 30.06.2015, 284 Earned Leave and 300 Half Pay Leave were at his credit. There is also reference of medical fitness certificate issued by Civil Surgeon. The Respondent No.2 accordingly sent proposal to the Respondent No.1 by letter dated 15.10.2018. However, since then no decision is taken and the issue is simply pending at the level of Respondent No.1. In the meantime, the Applicant stands retired on 30.09.2020.

Tribunal's orders

7. Learned P.O. on instructions submits that the Respondent No.1 will decide the issue of leave and thereafter only papers will be processed for grant of pension.

8. Indeed, necessary orders as the case may be, ought to have been passed by the Respondent No.1 much earlier but the department is simply sitting over the matter. The Applicant is deprived of retiral benefits for near about three years due to sheer lethargy and negligence on the part of Respondent No.1 in the matter.

9. In view of above, both the Original Applications are required to be disposed of with suitable directions. Hence the following order.

ORDER

(A) The Respondent No.1 is directed to pass appropriate order in the matter of leave proposal forwarded by the Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Department vide letter dated 15.10.2018 within four weeks from today and the decision be communicated to the Applicant.

(B) After the decision on leave issue, the Respondent No.1 should take further necessary steps to release retiral benefits of the Applicant as per his entitlement in law and ensures release of monetary benefits within one months thereafter.

(C) The Respondent No.1 is at liberty to call for necessary information if required from the Applicant and the Applicant shall also co-operate the department.

(D) In view of above, both the Original Applications are disposed of with no order as to costs.
