Heard Ms. Sonali Pawar, learned Advocate holding for Shri S.S. Dere, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents. 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that the Applicant is seeking 'Inter District Transfer' to the establishment of 'Superintendent of Police, Nanded' and had submitted Application on 14.12.2020 for consideration of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'. The 'Superintendent of Police, Nanded' has also consented to accept the Applicant on 'Inter District Transfer'. 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that no action has been taken so far by 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'. 4. Learned Advocate apprehends that the consent given by 'Superintendent of Police, Nanded' may be revoked even if the approval were to be given later on by 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'. The Applicant in such eventually will not be able to join on establishment of 'Superintendent of Police, Nanded'. 5. The important fact in case of Applicant is that he had applied long back on 14.12.2020 for 'Inter District Transfer' to 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'. Hence, 'Superintendent of Police, Nanded' is informed to keep atleast 'One Post' of 'Police Constable' available from those earmarked for 'Inter District Transfer'; so that as and when Applicant is relieved by 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'

he can forthwith join on establishment of 'Superintendent of Police, Nanded'.

6. The present O.A. No.191/2024 being about 'Inter District Transfer' be tagged along with O.A. No.26/2022 & Others all of which are about 'Inter District Transfer' of 'Police Constables' who are serving in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'.

7. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.

8. Issue notice before admission returnable on 05.03.2024.

9. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

10. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</p> <p>2. Learned Advocate for Applicant stated that 'Order of Attachment' dated 31.01.2024 of 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' to assign Applicant 'New Duty' (नव्याने कर्तव्य) in 'Control Room' has been issued later bearing 'Outward No. क्र.पशा-८/पो.अधि. / बदली/ २०२४/ १३७४;' while the 'Transfer Order' dated 31.01.2024 to Transfer 'Respondent No.2' from 'Control Room' to post of 'In Charge' of 'Kavathemahankal, Police Station' was issued earlier bearing 'Outward No. क्र.पशा-८/पो.अधि. / बदली/ २०२४/१३७२.'</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant then referred to the 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'P.E.B.' by which other 'Police Inspectors' who had earlier reported to 'Control Room' including the 'Respondent No.2' were all transferred as 'In Charge' of 'Police Stations' by 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' in exercise of 'Statutory Powers' under 'Section 22N(2)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicant emphasized that in respect of Applicant without any formal approval of 'P.E.B.' the 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' has included a separate paragraph so as to be able to issue 'Order of Attachment' of Applicant to 'Control Room'. The 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'PEB' also do not affirm that 'Statutory Powers' were used by 'Superintendent</p>

of Police, Sangli' in accordance with provisions of 'Section 22 N(2) of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'.

5. Learned Advocate for Applicant also stated that the 'Special I.G.P, Kolhapur Range' has issued 'Transfer Orders' on 12.01.2024 to move several 'Police Inspectors' including Respondent No.2 from 'Kolhapur District' to 'Sangli District' for implementation of the directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 on grounds of either being posted in of 'Home District' or completion of tenure of 3 Years in last 4 Years in 'Revenue District'. However, 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' did not forthwith issue subsequent 'Transfer Orders' of such 'Police Inspector' but instead temporarily placed them in 'Control Room'. The 'Transfers Orders' of such 'Police Inspector' including Respondent No.2 came to be issued belatedly on 31.01.2024 after approval in meeting of 'P.E.B.' held on 31.01.2024.

6. Learned P.O. then stated that the 'P.E.B.', held on 31.01.2024 under 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' had considered the seriousness of the report submitted against Applicant by 'Sub Divisional Police Officer, Jat, District Sangli' which related to intentional delay on part of Applicant before registration of C.R. No.29/2024 under Section 354 of 'I.P.C.' read with 'Section 3' of 'S.C. & S.T. 'Prevention of Atrocity) Act, 1989'.

7. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon stated that 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' did not take concurrence from 'Chief Election Officer, Maharashtra State' as required under 'Para 8' of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 before shifting of Applicant to 'Control Room' and prior to transfers of all 'Police Inspectors' from Control Room to posts of 'In Charge' of 'Police Stations' by 'Transfer Order' dated 31.01.2024.

8. Learned P.O. stated that Respondent No.2 was transferred by 'Special I.G.P, Kolhapur Range' Order dated 12.01.2024 only because Kolhapur District was his 'Home District'. The 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' had acted promptly in case of Applicant because of the seriousness of offence mentioned in C.R. No.29/2024 which has been also recorded in 'Minutes of Meeting', of 'PEB' held on 31.01.2024.

The 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' even though may have been required to act forthwith in respect of report submitted against Applicant by the 'Sub Divisional Police Officer, Jat, District Sangli' however could not have over looked the provisions of law while passing 'Order of Attachment' of Applicant on 31.01.2024 which is 'prima-facie' not as per provisions of Section 22 N(2) of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'. The 'Order of Attachment' dated 31.01.2024 of Applicant to 'Control Room' issued by 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' is rather cryptic and uses ambiguous words 'पुढील आदेश होईतोपर्यंत तात्पुरत्या स्वरूपात नव्याने कर्तव्य (DUTY) नेमण्यात येत आहे'. Besides it appears from 'Order of Attachment' bearing Outward No. क्र.पशा-८/ पो.अधि./ बदली/ २०२४/ १३७४ dated 31.01.2024 was done after 'Respondent No.2' had been transferred as 'In-Charge, of 'Kavathemahankal Police Station' by Transfer Order dated 31.01.2024 bearing Outward No. क्र.पशा-८/ पो.अधि./ बदली/ २०२४/ १३७२ dated 31.01.2024 which also indicates that it was after thought on part of 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' to shift Applicant from post of 'In-Charge of Kavathemahankal, Police Station' as 'Respondent No.2' had already been brought in earlier as 'In-Charge, of 'Kavathemahankal Police Station'. The use of paraphrase such as 'पुढील आदेश होईतोपर्यंत तात्पुरत्या स्वरूपात नव्याने कर्तव्य (DUTY) नेमण्यात येत आहे' does not exhibit any transparency in actions taken by 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli'.</p> <p>10. The 'Order of Attachment' dated 31.01.2024 of 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' in respect of Applicant therefore does not inspire much confidence as to whether there indeed was any 'Application of Mind' since no reliance has been placed on provisions of laws; unlike when it had been done for transfers of all other 'Police Inspectors' under 'Section 22 N(2)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'. Further there seems to be no compliance of directions in 'Para 8' of</p>

'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 which required 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' to take prior approval of all transfers of 'Police Inspectors' as 'In-Charge' of 'Police Stations' including of 'Respondent No.2' in place of Applicant to serve on post of 'In-Charge' of 'Kavathemahakal, Police Station'. Hence, the action taken by 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' cannot be upheld as valid in eyes of law. In view of the reasons recorded above '*Status Qua Ante*' is required to be granted in favour of Applicant. Applicant is accordingly permitted to join back on post of 'In-Charge Police Inspector' of 'Kavathemahakal, Police Station, District Sangli'. The 'Respondents No.2' if required can be brought back by 'Superintendent of Police, Sangli' to serve in 'Control Room'.

Learned Advocate for Applicants then narrated details of the 'Incident of Theft' of 'One Central Unit' of 'EVM' which has resulted in 'Suspension Orders' being served on Applicants. She</p>

added that 40 EVM's & VVPAT's which were meant to be used only for 'Training and Awareness' purposes had been stored in 'Office Building' of 'Tahsil Office, Saswad, District Pune'.

4. Learned Advocate for Applicant produced copy report submitted on 06.02.2024 by 'District Collector and District Election Officer, Pune' to ACS & Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State about this 'Incident' of Theft' of 'One Central Unit' of 'EVM' which mentions in details about 'Security & Safety' arrangements which had been made for storage of 40 EVM's & VVPAT's in 'Office Building' of Tahsil Office, Saswad, District Pune about ongoing 'Police Investigations'.

5. Learned Advocate for Applicant then drew to the 'Suspension Orders' which have been issued by (i) 'Revenue and Forest Department' on 09.02.2024 for Applicants in O.A.No.205/2024 and O.A.No.206/2024, (ii) Home Department on 08.02.2024 for Applicant in O.A.No.207/2024 to emphasize that they only refer to the directions of the 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 06.02.2024 to 'Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra'.

6. Learned Advocate for Applicants further referred to the G.A.D. G.R. dated 07.02.2024 which has been issued as per directions of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 06.02.2024 to constitute an 'Enquiry Committee' of 'High Level Officers' to enquire about the 'Incident of Theft' of 'One Control Unit' of EVM on 04.02.2024 from premises of 'Office Building' of 'Tahsil Office, Saswad, District Pune'. She mentioned that these 'High Level Officers' consisting of (i) 'Divisional Commissioner Pune' as Chairman and (ii) 'Special I.G.P, Kolhapur

The learned PO further stated that 'Election Commission of India letter dated 06.02.2024' addressed to Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra has reference to report submitted by ACS & Chief Electoral Officer Maharashtra State on 06.02.2024 which had enclosed the report of 'District Collector & DEO Pune' dated 05.02.2024 about the 'Incident of Theft' of 'One Central Unit' of 'EVM' from premises of 'Office Building' of 'Tahsil Office, Saswad, District Pune'.</p> <p>11. The learned Advocate for Applicant and learned PO for Respondents were heard at length about the legal challenge to 'Suspension Orders' of Applicants under provisions of 'Section 19' of the 'Administrative Tribunals Act 1985'.</p> <p>12. The 'Suspension Orders' issued by 'Revenue and Forest Department' on 09.02.2024 in respect of Applicants in OA No.207/2024 and (ii) Home Department on 08.02.2024 in respect of Applicant in OA No.205/2024 and OA No.206/2024 came to be issued hurriedly, it was of material importance for the 'Cadre Controlling Authorities' of the Applicants to consider the report submitted by District Collector & District Election Officer, Pune to ACS & Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State on 06.02.2024 and the report of 'District Collector & DEO Pune' dated 05.02.2024 which divulged many facts relating to the 'Incident of Theft' of 'One Central Unit' of 'EVM' from amongst 40 EVM's and VVPAT's kept separately in 'Separate Departmental Warehouses' as per instruction in Election Commission of India letter dated 11.11.2021. The arrangements made for 'Safety and Security' of these 40 EVM's and VVPAT's which were stored in 'Separate Departmental Warehouses' to have been commensurate as the 'Separate Departmental Warehouse' was co-located adjacent to the 'Sub Treasury' And 'Sub Jail' in Office</p>

	<p>Building of Tahsil Office, Saswad, District, Pune. Further, the 'Enquiry Report' of committee of 'High Level Officers' was also expected to be submitted to 'Additional Chief Secretary' and Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' by letter dated 12.02.2024 which is expected to throw further light on about many other aspects which led to the 'Incidence of Theft' of 'One Central Unit' of 'EVM' on intervening night of 04.02.2024. The relevant directions of Election Commission of India which required the 40 EVM's & VVPAT's to be stored in 'Separate Designated Warehouses' under direct charge of (i) Sub-Divisional Officer, (ii) Tahsildar & (iii) Sub-Divisional Police Officer become pertinent to decide about the individual culpability of Applicants. The guidelines of Election Commission of India which specific mention the protocol for 'Security and Safety' applicable to 'Several Designated Warehouses' as compared to 'FLC Storing Rooms' should have also been referred to by both (i) Revenue & Forest Department and (ii) Home Department. Hence, all these material facts were required to be considered by (i) 'Revenue and Forest Department', (ii) Home Department to establish that there indeed was 'Application of Mind'. Legal Principles laid down by several landmark judgments of (i) 'Hon'ble Supreme Court' and (ii) 'Hon'ble Bombay High Court' in respect of exercise of 'Statutory Powers' to issue 'Suspension Order' should have been referred to as otherwise these would be vulnerable in Judicial Review on grounds such as (i) Unlawful Exercise of Statutory Powers (ii) Arbitrary Exercise of Statutory Powers.</p>

The 'Suspension Orders' issued by (i) 'Revenue and Forest Department' on 09.02.2024, (ii) Home Department on 08.01.2024 have been issued under Rule 4(1)(a) of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules 1979 are clearly in contemplation of 'Disciplinary Proceedings' against the Applicants. Hence evidently, the action taken against Applicants is of 'Interim Suspension' and not 'Suspension as Punishment' as finely distinguished by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in RP Kapur vs. Union of India :AIR 1964 SC 787. Hence, taking into consideration the observation of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India both (i) 'Revenue and Forest Department' & (ii) 'Home Department' would be at liberty to review the 'Suspension Orders' of the Applicants as per provisions of Rule 5(c) of the 'MCS (D & A) Rules 1976' as 'prima-facie', the 'File Noting' indicate that there was no independent 'Application of Mind' by 'Competent Authority' while exercising 'Statutory Powers' under provisions of Rule 4(1) (a) of 'Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979' and 'Suspension Order' of the Applicants it appears came to be mechanically issued based only on the directions of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 06.02.2024 to 'Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra'.</p> <p>14. The 'Suspension Order' issued hurriedly against Applicants without considering all facts and circumstances relating to 'Incident of Theft' of 'One Control Unit' of 'EVM' from the premises of 'Office Building' of 'Tahsil Office, Saswad, District Pune' therefore appears to be 'Stigmatic in Nature' because Applicants have been pronounced guilty even before 'Disciplinary Proceedings' have been initiated under MCS (D & A) Rules 1979 and as highlighted by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India have the effect of being 'Suspension as Punishment'.</p>
