They have one and the same grievance that they have not been given the benefits of time bound promotion at any stage from 1.1.1996 onwards. Similarly, their pay is not fixed as per 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> &amp; 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission as they were not given the benefits of time bound promotion, which involves application of G.R dated 3.8.2001.</p> <p>4. Learned P.O is instructed by Shri Kiran Shinde &amp; Shri Shashikant Tijare, Desk Officer, Finance Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai, who are present before this Tribunal.</p> <p>5. The officers from the Finance Department have explained the application of the G.R dated 3.8.2001 and so also application of Annexures I &amp; II as per the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> &amp; 7<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission. The assistance rendered by the Officers from the Finance Department is found very useful and we are of the view that this issue can be sorted out by sending the matter to the Finance Department as the expertise in the Finance Department is required to deal with this financial aspect.</p> <p>6. The Tribunal, though is competent to decide the legality of the G.Rs dated 17.5.2003 and 5.7.2010, it cannot go into the financial aspect of the said G.Rs when the arithmetic calculations are involved threadbare. We are not the expertise in Finance, it is proper and correct to refer the matter to the Finance Department, where the experience and expertise in Finance are available.</p>




