G.R. dated 09.04.2018; so as to ascertain if any 'Non-Executive Post' of 'Awal Karkoons' in adjacent 'Tahsil Offices' are likely to be available during of 'General Transfer 2024'.

1. Heard Shri R.G. Nirmal, learned Advocate for Applicant present through 'Video-Conference' and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. The learned Advocate for Applicants states that the Applicants who are working on post of 'Lower Grade Stenographer' in the office of 'Commissioner GST, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' are seeking transfer respectively to 'Nanded District' and 'Aurangabad District'.

3. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that parents of both Applicants have serious 'Medical Conditions'. The 'Mother' of Applicant No.1 suffers from 'Paralysis' while 'Father' of Applicant No. 2 had suffered from 'Mediated Encephalitis, Facio-Dystonic Seizures'.

4. Learned PO refers to guidelines in 'Para 14' of GAD GR dated 30.10.2015 to state that Applicants who belong to cadre 'Lower Grade Stenographer' cannot therefore be transferred out from establishment of 'Commissioner GST, Maharashtra State, Mumbai'.

5. Learned Advocate for Applicant cites the case of Smt. Nisha Nagrale 'Lower Grade Stenographer' who was also appointed like Applicant in establishment of 'Commissioner GST, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' based on guidelines in 'Para 14' of GAD GR dated 30.10.2015.

6. Learned PO clarifies that case of Smt. Nisha Nagrale 'Lower Grade Stenographer' her request for transfer to Nagpur was considered as per earlier GAD GR dated 03.06.2011 while the cases of the Applicants are covered by GAD GR dated 15.05.2019.

7. The learned PO however to seek 'Additional Information' about Order dated 09.08.2017 of 'Special Sales Tax, Commissioner Maharashtra State Mumbai' by which Smt. Nisha Nagrale, 'Lower Grade Stenographer' who was transferred to office of 'Joint Commissioner, Sales Tax, Nagpur' by invoking provisions of (i) Finance Department GAD Gr 03.04.2014 and (ii) 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005. Thus it would be necessary to ascertain how Order dated 09.08.2017 of 'Special Sales Tax, Commissioner Maharashtra State Mumbai' in respect Smt. Nisha Nagrale 'Lower Grade Stenographer' came to be issued although restrictions were placed by guidelines in 'Para 14' of by GAD GR 30.10.2015 on transfers of 'Lower Grade Stenographers' who had been recruited only for Government Offices located in Greater Mumbai; so as to ascertain if there was any discrimination against Applicants.

8. The learned PO accordingly given time of 'Two Weeks' to file 'Affidavit-in-Reply on behalf of Respondent No.2 to 4.
