- 1. Heard Shri K. R. Jagdale, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Kranti Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The Applicant was serving on the post of Tahsildar on the establishment of Sub Divisional Officer, Karad, Dist. Satara. He was subjected to disciplinary proceeding for absenteeism under Rule 8 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979. After inquiry, the disciplinary authority i.e. S.D.O. by order dated 01.06.2017 removed the Applicant from service invoking Rule 5(8) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979. Being aggrieved by it, the Applicant has filed appeal with application for condonation of delay before the Collector, However, the Collector, Satara by order dated 17.01.2019 dismissed the appeal stating that appeal is filed after the period of expiry of limitation. Being aggrieved by it, the Applicant has filed present O.A.
- 3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant has pointed out that the Applicant along with appeal memo has filed separate application for condonation of delay of 7 months and 25 days stating that he is sole earning member of the family and due to illness of old parents, he could not file appeal within 45 days of limitation. However, the Collector, Satara without deciding application for condonation of delay straight way dismissed the appeal. He, therefore, prayed to quash and set aside the impugned order.

Tribunal's orders

- 4. Learned P.O. also concedes that matter needs to be remitted back to Collector, Satara for deciding application for condonation of delay on its own merit and to decide the appeal if delay is condoned.
- 5. Perusal of record reveals that even though there was separate application for condonation of delay, the Collector, Satara completely ignored it and proceeded to dispose of the appeal on assumption that there was no such application for condonation of delay. In fact, he was obliged to decide the application for condonation of delay first and then to proceed with appeal.
- 6. It is thus explicit that the impugned order dismissing the appeal without deciding application for condonation of delay is clearly unsustainable in law and liable to be quashed.
- 7. In view of above, impugned order dated 17.01.2019 is quashed and set aside. The matter is remitted back to Collector, Satara for direction to decide the application for condonation of delay made by the applicant on its own merit within six weeks from today and if delay is condoned then to decide the appeal within one month from the date of decision on application for condonation of delay in accordance to law.
- 8. The decision as the case may be, shall be communicated to the Applicant within two weeks thereafter.
- 9. No order as to costs.

- 1. Heard Shri M.D. Lonkar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Heard submission of Shri M.D. Lonkar, learned Advocate for the Applicant for quite some time.
- 3. This O.A. is arising from very peculiar situation, the Applicant was initially appointed as a candidate sponsored by Employment Exchange by order dated 06.01.1981 on the post of Urdu Typist as temporary Appointment. However, later by order dated 07.05.1991 Government appointed him on the post of Stenographer (Higher Grade Urdu) temporarily and he was continued in service. Later Government by order dated 16.06.1995 continued the appointment on the post of Stenographer (Higher Grade Urdu) till the availability of M.P.S.C. candidate. However, no candidate was made available by M.P.S.C. and the Applicant continued on the appointed post and stands retired on 31.08.2017.
- Interesting to note that when the Applicant was appointed on the post of Urdu Typist as well as Stenographer (Higher Grade - Urdu) no recruitment Rules were in place. It is for the first time in 1994 the Government framed recruitment Rules for Stenographer (Higher Grade - Urdu) but no candidate made available through M.P.S.C. correspondence was also made to change recruitment Rules but in vain. It is on these backgrounds the Applicant continued his service as Stenographer (Higher Grade - Urdu).
- 5. He was terminated by order dated 30.11.2016 on the ground that he did not possess requisite

qualification for the post of Stenographer (Higher Grade - Urdu). He challenged it by filing this O.A. wherein interim relief was granted by the Tribunal by order dated 06.12.2016. On the basis of interim relief the Applicant continued his service and on attaining the age of superannuation he retired on 31.08.2017.

- 6. The perusal of record further reveals that the Applicant had filed O.A. No.68/2004 for regularization on the post of Stenographer (Higher Grade Urdu) but it was dismissed on 01.09.2005 since the Applicant did not possess requisite qualification. Despite dismissal of O.A. the Applicant was continued in service.
- 7. It is on above background the Applicant has challenged termination order *inter-alia* contending that he was not at fault and Government himself appointed him on the post of Stenographer (Higher Grade Urdu) and availed his services for almost 26 years and now left high and dry.
- 8. Learned Advocate for the Applicant in alternative submission contended that the Applicant was possessing necessary qualification for the post of Urdu Typist when he was appointed by order dated 06.01.1981 and further pointed out that it was through Employment Exchange Office and not back door entry. Emphasizing on this aspect he contended that the Applicant services can be regularized for the post of Urdu Typist if not found eligible for the post of Stenographer (Higher Grade Urdu).
- 9. He has further pointed out that in somewhat similar situation the Government has regularized services of Smt. Premila J. Kundhadia & Javed Abdul Wahid Khan on the representation made by them by order dated 09.02.2015.
- 10. However, there is no pleading for claiming alternative relief for regularization on the post of Urdu Typist. Learned Advocate for the Applicant therefore seeks one week time to file M.A. for necessary amendment, one week time is granted.

- While hearing this ma going through the factual position which is mentioned by the leaned P.O. that at present all the Marathi medium Practice Schools attached to D.Ed college in Maharashtra are closed down for want of students in Marathi medium primary schools. The Practice Schools attached to D.Ed college is run by only Zilla Parishad and Municipal Corporation and therefore all the 48 teachers including the present Applicant working earlier in those schools are shifted to either Zilla Parishad or Municipal Corporation by accommodating them in those establishment.
- The Applicant is also accommodated earlier in Zilla Parishad in Pimpri, Chinchwad and now in The Applicant has Municipal Corporation. challenged the earlier appointment in Zilla Parishad. The Single Bench by its judgment dated 23.03.2022 while allowing the O.A.No.900 of 2021 has directed the Respondent to take the decision and accommodate him as per G.R. dated 15.09.2020. After going through the said G.R. we understand that the teachers are to be accommodated on the same post and non-teaching staff is to be appointed post of the other non-teaching the [*P.T.O*. establishments.

- 4. Considering the educational qualification of the Applicant and the post which was earlier given to him was of teacher and as per G.R. he was to be given the post of teacher and therefore he was given the post of teaching in Municipal Corporation. However, the Applicant demands that the service conditions are not to be changed and his establishment should not be changed and to be allowed to be accommodated in Government only. If the State of Maharashtra is not running any Practice Schools attached to D.Ed college, we fail to understand whether and how he can be given job in the said establishment without changing his service conditions.
- 5. At present learned Member (Judicial) who has decided O.A.No.900/2021 is heading the Division Bench at Mumbai and therefore this Contempt Application which is the subject matter of the Division Bench can be taken by the said Bench therefore we think it is appropriate to transfer this C.A. before the Division Bench wherein the same Member (Judicial) has decided the O.A., is party to the said Division Bench.
- 6. Matter is to be placed before the Division Bench tomorrow i.e. on 16.06.2022.
