Infact the transfer of Applicants who are from cadre of 'Dv.CEOs; BDO's & Assistant BDO's' were not necessitated as per directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2024' as transfer were to be only in respect of those 'Dy.CEOs; BDO's effected & Assistant BDO's' as mentioned in 'Para 5 who were directly deployed for election works by respective 'District Collectors and District Election Officers' during 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024'. Hence it is now for 'Rural Development Department' to consider how grievances of Applicants who are from cadre of 'Dy. C.E.O., BDO's. & Assistant B.D.O.' can redressed expeditiously during ensuing 'General Transfer: 2024'.

- applicant is challenging the impugned suspension order dated 11.7.2024. Ld. Advocate for the applicant points out that the applicant was working as Tahsildar, Khed, Pune. He was earlier working as Tahsildar, Mohol, District Solapur until he came to be transferred from Mohol to Khed vide order dated 16.6.2023. He points out that on the basis of a complaint filed by RTI Activist, the Divisional Commissioner conducted an enquiry against the applicant. The applicant gave detailed explanation regarding the observations made by the Divisional Commissioner vide communication dated 8.3.2023 and was under a bonafide belief that the explanation given by him was accepted by the respondents. Ld. Advocate for the applicant produces a copy of representation dated 2.3.2024 made by the applicant to the Hon'ble Chief Minister regarding the threat given by local MLA of placing the applicant under suspension or transfer.
- 3. Ld. Advocate for the applicant seeks interim relief against the impugned suspension dated 11.7.2024 on the ground that the order has been passed for extraneous consideration at the behest of the sitting MLA of the said Constituency. He also pointed out that the order suffers from total non-application of mind. He points out that the charges against the applicant are of trifling nature. He relies on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in State of Maharashtra Vs. Dr. Subhash Dhondiram Mane (2015) 4 Mh.L.J. 791 and Union of India & Anr. Vs. Ashok Kumar Aggarwal (2013) 16 SCC 147.
