2. Present O.A. is filed by six Applicants and out of them, two are retired from service. The Applicants are challenging the impugned orders of recovery sought to be made from the retiral benefits as well as Pay and Allowances of the Applicants. The recovery seems to have been ordered due to excess payment made to them on account of wrong fixation of pay scale and conferment of benefits.
3. The Applicants belong to Class-^{III} employees. In view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Civil Appeal No.11527/2014 (State of Punjab and others Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer), decided on 18th December, 2014**, the recovery from employees belonging to Class-^{III}, recovery from retired employees and recovery from employees when the excess payment has been made for a period in excess of five years before the order of recovery is issued, is not permissible.
4. In view of above, interim relief in terms of Para 10(c) of O.A. is granted.
5. Learned Counsel for the Applicants is directed to serve the amended O.A. to the Respondents in the meantime. Adjourned for filing of the reply of Respondents.
