Learned Counsel Mr. Lonkar has submitted that applicant has challenged the transfer order on the following grounds:
 - (a) Transfer order of the applicant is in contravention of Sections 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties, Act, 2005.
 - (b) Transfer order of Respondent No.4 from Kolhapur in place of the applicant is by the same order.

- 1. Applicant working as Chief Accounts and Finance Officer, challenges order dated 11.10.2024 issued by Respondent No.1, thereby transferring Respondent No.2 in place of the Applicant as Chief Accounts and Finance Officer, Zilla Parishad, Pune from Municipal Corporation, Ahmednagar and transferred te Applicant to the post of Deputy Director, GST Commissionerate, Mumbai.
- 2. Learned Counsel Mr. Bandiwadekar has submitted that copy of O.A. is served to the concern yesterday at 3.30 p.m.. He has challenged the transfer order on the following grounds:
 - (a) By order dated 06.10.2021 Applicant was transferred and he joined on 12.10.2021. Thus, Applicant has completed the tenure of three years.
 - (b) Applicant's transfer is mid-term as the transfer order is passed violating Section 4(4)(ii) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties, Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred as 'ROTA 2005' for brevity).
 - (c) Learned Counsel Mr. Bandiwadekar has submitted that applicant has been informed about his transfer by email on Friday, 11th October, 24 at 10.00 p.m. from Z.P. Pune and he stood relieved and transferred to Mumbai. Thus applicant approached the Tribunal yesterday i.e. on 14.10.2024 and has served copy to the Respondents. Applicant has not handed over his charge.



(d) Learned Counsel Mr, Bandiwadekar has submitted that there is patent breach of Rule 8 (page 33) of the Revenue Division Allotment for appointment by nominal and promotion to the posts of Group A and Gorup B (Gazetted and Non-Gazetted) of the Government of Maharashtra Rules, 2015 wherein such officers shall be eligible for transfer as per the ROTA 2005.

(e) Learned Counsel has submitted that Respondent No.2 was transferred to Ahmednagar by order dated 20.04.2022. Respondent No.2 was earlier in Nashik Division and thereafter he was allotted Ahmednagar, so he did not complete the period of

three years when he was posted on promotion.

(f) Learned Counsel Mr. Bandiwadekar has relied on Rule 7 and Rule 12 of the Revenue Division Allotment for appointment by nominal and promotion to the posts of Group A and Gorup B (Gazetted and Non-Gazetted) of the Government of Maharashtra Rules, 2015 dated 14.07.2021. He has submitted that the case of Respondent No.2 is neither covered under Rule 7 nor under Rule 12 of putting minimum period of three years at particular Division.

(g) Applicant's mother is blind, paralyzed and seeking psychological

consultation in Pune.

- (h) Applicant challenges transfer order on the point of competency of the transferring authority issuing the order of transfer. Applicant has submitted that considering the pay scale of the applicant, applicant falls in Class (a) of the Table appended to Section 6 of the said Act. Thus, transfer order is to be issued by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, who is the competent authority in case of applicant and not the immediate Superintending Authority.
- 3. In support of his submissions learned Counsel has relied on the judgment of this Tribunal dated 09.10.2024 in O.A.No.1006/2024, S.S. Mali Versus The State of Maharashtra & Ors. wherein Rules 29 and 31 of the Maharashtra Civil Service (General Conditions of Service) Rules, 1981 is discussed.
- 4. Learned Counsel Ms. Mahajan appearing for Respondent No.2 has submitted that Respondent No.2 has taken charge on 14.10.2024. Learned Counsel Ms. Mahajan has pointed out Clause 9 of the Election Commission guidelines dated 31.07.2024. Learned Counsel Ms. Mahajan seeks time.
- 5. O.A is kept back as nobody is present.



6. At the request of learned P.O. adjourned to 16.10.2024.

7. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be

- 1. Mr. Kunal Damle a/w. Ms. Shraddha Dube Patil i/by M/S. Jay & Co. for MIDC though not party Respondent is present. Since, MIDC is not party Respondent at present, MIDC has no locus.
- 2. Applicant prays that Respondents be directed to place before the Tribunal record and proceedings of the order dated 11.10.2024 and after examining its legality and validity regarding the transfer of Applicant and Respondent No.4, the Tribunal be pleased to hold and declare that, the impugned order is illegal qua the Applicant and by suitable order the same may be quashed and set aside. Applicant further prays that Respondents No.1 and 3 be directed to restore the order dated 06.08.2024 so far as the Applicant is concerned and direct Respondent No.3 to issue the movement order in respect of the Applicant within one week from the date of the order of this Hon. Tribunal.
- 3. Learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre has submitted that by impugned order dated 11.10.2024, the Applicant who is Deputy Collector and who was posted as Regional Officer, Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC), Nashik on 06.08.2024 came to be transferred and posted as Deputy Chief Officer, Shree Sai Baba Sansthan, Shirdi, District Ahmednagar. Learned Counsel has submitted that by order dated 06.08.2024 applicant

was transferred from Parner, District Nagar to Regional Officers, MIDC, Nashik. Applicant could not join as Regional Officer, MIDC, Nashik pursuant to order dated 06.08.2024 because the movement has not been issued by the Secretary, Industry Department, MIDC. On 07.08.2024 (Exhibit A-5) the applicant has made written request to the Principal Secretary, Industry, Mantralaya to let him join his new posting. On 07.08.2024 (Exhibit A-7) Mr. Uday Samant, Hon'ble Cabinet Minister of Industry has given order to Principal Secretary and Additional Chief Secretary (Revenue) that Respondent No.4, Mr. Deepak Santosh Patil is to be posted as Regional Officer, MIDC on deputation. Pursuant to this letter, transfer order dated 11.10.2024 (Exhibit A-1) was issued.

- 4. Learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre has submitted that now the applicant by order dated 11.10.2024 is transferred as Deputy Chief Officer, Shree Sai Baba Sansthan, Shirdi, District Ahmednagar on deputation. Learned Counsel has pointed out that by order dated 11.10.2024 Respondent No.4, Mr. Deepak Patil is transferred from Jalna on deputation to Nashik in the place of applicant. Learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre has relied and pointed out Clause 9 of Circular dated 11.02.2015 (Exhibit A-8) issued in pursuance for implementing the provisions of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties, Act, 2005. He has submitted that at Clause 9 of the said Circular the G.A.D. has taken policy decision and the present case of the applicant is protected under Clause 9 of the said Circular.
- 5. Learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre has submitted that Respondent No.4, Mr. Deepak Santosh Patil was posted at Jalna, Marathwada region under Divisional Allotment Rules of 2021 and he has put in only eight months in Marathwada region. Therefore he cannot be shifted in any other Division unless he completes his tenure of three years. Learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre has submitted that applicant was transferred on deputation though he has never made any request. Learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre has submitted that wife of the applicant is working as Deputy Collector, Nashik and applicant was working outside Nashik for six years, so the



applicant made request that he may be posted in Nashik. Learned Counsel has submitted that the partial modification is made only because of the letter given by the Hon'ble Minister and that cannot be exceptional circumstances or special reasons. Applicant's post of R.O. MIDC is not counted as Election duty and the post of Respondent No.4, SDO, Jalna, is notified post of Election Commission.

- 6. Learned P.O. seeks time to take instructions.
- 7. Time granted.
- 8. Learned Counsel Ms. Mahajan has submitted that by order dated 31.01.2024 passed by this Tribunal in O.A.No.942/2023, Mr. Rajiv V. Shinde & Ors. Vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors. all the Deputy Collectors are shuffled as per their region in the Regional Cadre. Learned Counsel Ms. Mahajan has submitted that applicant's Home District is Nashik and therefore he cannot work during the election period at Nashik.
- 9. Considered submissions. The Clause 9 of Circular dated 11.02.2015 which is relied by learned Counsel Mr. Chandratre reads as below:

In view that Applicant and Respondent No.4 both have not joined there transferred post, the post of R.O. M.I.D.C. is to be kept vacant till further orders of the Tribunal. Applicant and Respondent No.4 not to join on their transferred post and if at all any other person is working on the post, he/she may continue on the post. Status quo to be maintained.

- 10. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 11. Issue notice before admission returnable on 17.10.2024.

- 12. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. - 4. Learned Counsel Mr. Lonkar has tendered copy of service report wherein all the Respondents are served.
- 5. Respondent no.5, Mr. Shivaji B. Patil is present in person and seeks time to engage Counsel.
- 6. Leaned Counsel has submitted that the applicant has challenged the transfer order on the following grounds:
 - (a) Applicant's transfer order is passed violating Section 22N of the Maharashtra Police Act. Applicant was transferred as Superintendent of Police, Anti-Corruption Bureau, Thane by order dated 08.11.2022 (Exhibit-E). Thus he has not completed the requisite tenure of two years. Learned Counsel has submitted that applicant was transferred to Nagpur by order dated 07.11.2022 and on the next day the order was modified and the applicant was posted as Superintendent of Police, ACB, Thane. Before that Applicant was transferred from the post of Deputy Commissioner of Police, Economic Office Wing, Thane City to the post of Deputy Commissioner of Police, Nagpur City.
 - (b) Learned Counsel has submitted that Respondent No.5, Mr. Shivaji B. Patil was transferred from the post of Deputy Commissioner of Police, Zone-2, Navi Mumbai to the post of Deputy Commissioner of Police, Thane City.
 - (c) Learned Counsel has submitted that Respondent No.1 has not constituted meeting of Police Establishment Board-1 (PEB-1), thereby violating Section 22C of the PEB-1.
- 7. Learned C.P.O. has pointed out to order dated 07.10.2024 which are issued under Section 22N(2) of the Maharashtra Police Act which states that the Competent Authority can make mid-term transfers of police personnel in exceptional cases thus, in present case approval of the highest authority which is the competent authority has taken note in consultation with the Joint Chief Election Officer, State of Maharashtra. Learned C.P.O. has submitted that it is exceptional case as there is default on the part of the applicant in laxity of investigation and therefore the applicant is transferred



by taking measures under Section 22(N)(2) of the Maharashtra Police Act. Thus, she has submitted that there is no breach of any procedure. Hence, PEB-1 was not constituted.

- 8. Considered submissions made by learned Counsel as well as learned C.P.O. It appears that the applicant has no prima facie case in his favour to grant any interim relief. However, Respondents are directed to issue posting order in favour of the applicant as the applicant cannot be kept without posting.

Learned Counsel has submitted that Applicant, Circle Officer challenges the impugned transfer order dated 11.10.2024 issued by Respondent no.1 thereby transferring him from the post of Circle Officer, Jaigad, Tahsil Office, Ratnagiri to the post of Circle Officer, Land Acquisition Office, District Collector Office, Ratnagiri. Learned Counsel has submitted that the applicant challenges the transfer order dated 11.10.2024 issued in respect of Private Respondent No.2, Mr. Sarfraj M. Sandhe by which he is transferred on the applicant's post. Learned Counsel has submitted that the applicant challenges his transfer on the following grounds:
 - (i) Applicant was transferred as Circle Officer by order dated 13.09.2019. Hence, the transfer order is mid-term thereby violating Sections 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties, Act, 2005

- 2. The applicant challenges the impugned order dated 14.10.2024 transferring him from Zone Thane-3 to Grater Mumbai Zone-1 and transferring Respondent No. 2, from Jalgaon Zone-2 to Thane Zone-3 in his place as illegal and void ab initio as the same is issued in contravention of the provisions of Rule 8 of the Maharashtra Government Allotment of Revenue Division for appointment by nomination and promotion to Group-A and Group-B (Gazetted and Non-Gazetted) Rules, 2021.
- 3. Learned counsel submitted that the Applicant was promoted and posted to the post of Assistant Commissioner (Food), Group-A and allotted to Konkan-2 Division by order dated 15.12.2022 and Respondent No. 2 was also promoted to the post of Assistant Commissioner (Food), Group-A and allotted to Nasik Division by order dated 4.4.2022. Learned counsel submitted that thus the Applicant will be completing 3 years in Konkan Division-2 in December, 2025 and Respondent No. 2 will be completing 3 years in Nasik Division in April, 2025. Learned counsel further submitted that the Applicant is not relieved from his present place of posting.
- 4. Learned counsel Ms Deepa Panicker submits that Respondent No. 2 has filed Caveat Application and seeks time to file reply.
- 5. In view of the above, status quo to be maintained as on today.
