The learned PO is being instructed by Smt. Sheetal Sawant, Desk Officer, Finance Department.

This OA can safely be disposed of at this stage itself. An order of 8th November, 2016 issued by the State in the Finance Department is furnished for my perusal. It is retained on record. Thereby the deemed date of promotion is given to the Applicant from 27.3.2001. The further order with regard to the deemed date of promotion in the post of Assistant Commissioner, Sales Tax has not so far been given and both the sides are in fact not in any serious dispute that it would be more in the nature of consequential service benefits and will have to be accordingly granted. In Para 12 of the Affidavit-in-reply (Page 71 of the Paper Book), the Respondents themselves have mentined (on 6.6.2016) that the said deemed date of promotion for both the posts shall be given within three months. That time limit had already expired, but I think, practical considerations weigh with the Applicant and Mr. Lonkar, in all fairness, does not object to grant of further reasonable time. There is an issue of deemed date of promotion for the post of Deputy Commissiner of Sales Tax for which there is no specific prayer. However, I agree with the learned Advocate Shri Lonkar that it would also fall within the larger compass of consequential relief and as much as the Respondents have already over-short the time limit prescribed by themselves of three months for the post of Assistant Commissioner, Sales Tax, I think, it would be fair and reasonable to ask them to complete the said task in so far as the post of Deputy Commissioner of Sales Tax is concerned. I must make it clear that no further extension of time shall be given and further liberty is reserved for the Applicant, to if so advised bring an appropriate action for monetary benefits. With this liberty, this OA is disposed of with a direction that the Respondents shall complete in every respect the grant of deemed date to the Applicant to the post of Assistant Commissioner of Sales Tax and Deputy Commissioner of Sales Tax as indicated hereinaboave within a period of

The applicant a 'Staff Nurse' sensing peril to her continuation as such seeks interim relief in the terms which was granted in O.A.No. 189/2016 (Ms Madhuri Rane & 18 Ors. V/s. State of Maharashtra & 1 Anr., 14.3.2016).

I have heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, the learned Advocate for the applicant and Ms S. Suryawanshi, learned P.O. for the respondents strongly opposing the grant of any interim relief. I am of the opinion that on account of principle of similarly placed person and parity of reasoning benefits of the orders in case of Ms Madhuri Rane (Supra) and another order made by me in O.A. No.925/2016 (Ms A. D. Avhad & 11 Ors. V/s. State of Maharashtra & 1 Anr., 22.9.2016), same interim relief will have to be granted. In Ms. Avhad (Supra), I have reproduced the para 8 from the earlier order which I also do herein below and same interim relief is granted.

Para 8: I am, therefore, so inclined as to hold that I must exercise my powers of granting mandatory relief at interlocutory stage the net result whereof would be to place the present applicants exactly at par with the applicants of OAs No.311 of 2012 and 258 of 2014. It is however made clear that this interim order will be exactly in the same terms in which the applicants were given appointments for 364 days with all those terms and conditions and they will inter alia not be allowed to claim on the strength of this order alone what could be described as permanent appointment. All these terms and conditions will be read as a part of this order. They shall however be allowed to compete for the regular posts. However, in the event a candidate is selected and appointed on regular basis, these applicants will have to vacate their posts but it is also made clear that even then if other posts are lying vacant, then merely by reason of this order the applicants will not necessarily be refused appointment in the same capacity. With this abundant clarification and till further orders the interim relief is granted till 11.4.2016. Four weeks time is given to the respondents to comply. Hamdast. This O.A. be tagged along with OAs No.311 of 2012 and 258 of 2014."

Adjourned for affidavit-in-reply on 12.1.2017. Hamdast.




