In alternative, he submits that if it is not possible to accommodate him on any one of the posts asked by him, he be retained at present post. Later, at the time of general transfer of 2022, he gave nine options Karjat, Social Forestry Alibag, Thane Circle was one on the options and accordingly he was posted there.

Tribunal's orders

- 3. The Tribunal by order dated 30.05.2022 directed not to fill in the one post of Range Forest Officer Protection and Encroachment Department, Pune which was vacant at that time.
- 4. Thus, the situation emerges that Government had changed the circle from Nashik to Pune by order dated 18.06.2021 and obviously the Applicant is required to be posted in Pune Circle. However, he is posted in Thane Circle though he was his one of the options. However, now in view of change of circle from Nashik to Pune, the Applicant is entitled to Pune Circle. It appears, the Respondent No.2 lost sight of this aspect. Now, the general transfers of 2023 are due in next 3-4 months.

Therefore, on 12.01.2023, learned Counsel for the Applicant was directed to take instructions from the Applicant No.1 about her willingness to accept the post offered to her.
- 3. Learned P.O. submits that there is vacancy in Group 'D' post and if the Applicant No.1 is willing to accept the same, the O.A. can be disposed of.
- 4. Today, learned Counsel for the Applicants has filed additional affidavit of Applicant No.1 stating that she is ready to accept the Group 'D' post.
- 5. Since the name of Applicant No.1 is already in the waiting list, the question of substitution of Applicant No.2 in her place does not survive. It is only in case where the name of heir is deleted on account of age bar, in that event only, there may be consideration of substitution of another heir. Therefore, the claim of Applicant No.2 for substitution is untenable.
- 6. In view of above, M.A. and O.A. are disposed of with directions to Respondent No.2 to take further steps for appointment of Applicant No.1 in Group 'D' post since there is already vacancy available. Necessary orders be issued within a month from today.
- 7. No order as to costs.
