Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that new information about 'Inter Establishment Transfer' of 'Police Constables' to establishment of (i) 'Commissioners of Police' and (ii) 'Superintendent of Police' sought from 'Commandants S.R.P.F. Groups' is expected to be received by 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' by 22.02.2024 but it has to be prospectively considered in respect of year 2021-22.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then draws attention to updated information of existing vacancies for 'Inter District Transfer' in respect of 'Raigad District' disclosed by way of 'Short Affidavit' dated 30.01.2024 on behalf of 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' to specifically point out</p>

that 'Superintendent of Police, Raigad' on 14.07.2023 had revised figures about availability of posts of 'Police Constable' for 'Inter Establishment Transfer'. Infact as the revised figures are 27 posts instead of 19 posts as had been communicated earlier by 'Superintendent of Police, Raigad' on 12.12.2022 because of cancellation of earlier Order dated 12.01.2023 of 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' and due to issue of revised Order dated 05.07.2023 of 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai'.

5. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that therefore 8 post of 'Police Constables' had become available as on 14.07.2023 in 'Raigad District'; admittedly was much prior to commencement of present exercise 'Inter Establishment Transfer' for 2021-22 as conveyed by 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' letter dated 11.02.2024 to 'Commandants - S.R.P.F. Groups'.

6. Learned P.O. on the basis of information received from officer present on behalf of 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' states that 'Seniority List' for 'Inter Establishment Transfer' of 'Police Constables' is not maintained at level of 'Commandants - S.R.P.F. Groups' but only at 'State Level' in office of 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' which is based on 'Joining Dates' of the 'Police Constables'.

7. Learned P.O. to therefore inform 'Additional D.G.P., S.R.P.F., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' that upon submission of report by 'Superintendent of Police, Raigad' on 14.07.2023; 8 posts of 'Police Constables' in establishment of 'Superintendent of Police, Raigad' were confirmed to be available for 'Inter Establishment Transfer' which undoubtedly was much earlier to commencement of present exercise for 2021-22. Hence, these 8 posts should not be counted amongst total posts of 'Police Constables' which may now be communicated by 'Superintendent of Raigad' upto or even after 22.04.2024. These 8 posts should be kept aside and held vacant till 'Final Orders' in O.A. No.1182 of 2023 with O.A. No.151 of 2023 because Applicants were given liberty by 'Interim Order' dated 07.08.2023 to make Applications of their revised choices for 'Inter Establishment Transfer' within 'Two Weeks' and


