

- 3. Ld. PO strongly opposed grant of any interim relief. He produced the copy of the proceedings of Police Establishment Board (PEB) which met on 30.5.2016 in which the decision to transfer the

applicant was taken. He stated that the applicant is a very good officer and his services were required to be utilized in Court Company and that was the reason why he was transferred.

- It is seen that sub section 2 of Section 22N of the Maharashtra Police Act envisages that mid-term transfer of a police personnel can be made only in circumstances mentioned in the sub section in addition to what were provided in sub section 1 of Section 22N. The reason for mid-tenure transfer could be exceptional circumstances in public interest and on account of administrative exigencies. The proceedings of the PEB at Commissionerate level which was held on 30.5.2016 does not disclose any exceptional circumstances or public interest which is going to be served by mid-term transfer of the applicant.
- In the circumstances, interim relief sought in the OA of staying the transfer order of the applicant from Traffic Branch to Court Company is stayed till final disposal of this OA. The applicant will be allowed to work in his original post. Ld. PO seeks two weeks time to file reply to the OA.


