#### ORDER

1. Heard Smt Punam Mahajan, learned advocate for the Applicants and Shri K.B Bhise, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. The Applicants are seeking interim relief that no further promotion to the post of Deputy Secretary from the cadre of Under Secretary pursuant to the meeting of the Establishment Board held on 26.5.2017 may be made. The main ground on which this relief is sought that the Establishment Board has acted contrary to the G.R issued by the Government dated 18.10.1997, which clearly provides that roster will not apply to the post which are to be filled by transfer or on deputation. Learned Advocate Mrs Mahajan argued that there are total of 105 posts of Deputy Secretary in Mantralaya and in addition there are 23 posts due to deputation which are to be filled in different Departments. As per this G.R roster cannot be applied to these 23 posts when the promotions are being made. Learned Advocate Mrs Mahajan stated that this aspect has been totally ignored by the Establishment Board. She also pointed out that this G.R has been issued pursuant to the judgment of the Hon. Supreme Court in R.K SABHARWAL & ORS Vs. STATE OF PUNJAB & ORS : (1995) 2 Learned Advocate Smt Mahajan also stated that SCC 745. promotions so far made have been correctly made because they are within the cadre strength of Deputy Secretaries. However, any further promotions will be in violation of the aforesaid G.R. She, therefore, prayed that interim relief of staying any further promotion pursuant to the aforesaid meeting of the Establishment Board may be granted.

3. Learned P.O opposed grant of any interim relief at this stage without hearing the Respondents on the issue. On instructions from Shri G.B Gurav, Under Secretary, G.A.D, Mantralaya, Mumbai, learned P.O states that statement will be made on behalf of the Respondents on the next date and he sought four weeks time to file reply. Learned P.O further stated that till Tuesday, no further promotions will be effected. Issue of intuition relief is kept open.
