It is not a case of Applicant that some juniors are given compassionate appointment or waiting list is not maintained properly. This being so, the O.A. is premature.
- 4. At this juncture, learned Counsel for the Applicant sought permission to withdraw O.A. with liberty to sought information under RTI and to file proper O.A., if ground exists.
- 5. Allowed to withdraw O.A.
