**ORDER**

1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Counsel for Applicants and Shri S. D. Dole, learned Presenting Officers for the Respondents.

2. In these Original Applications, the Applicants have challenged the transfer order dated 04.07.2019 on the ground that same is not in consonance with Section 4(4) (ii) and 4(5) of the Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Act 2005). The Applicants were due for transfer but no transfer orders have been issued in April or May and, therefore, they assailed the transfer orders.

3. Having heard the learned Counsel for the Applicants, learned P.O. and on perusal of the file produced by the learned P.O. what transpires is as follows:-

4. It further transpires that earlier the powers of general transfer were delegated to the Secretary but it was withdrawn and Hon'ble Minister himself took over the powers. The perusal of Circular dated 01.06.2019 reveals that the powers of regular transfers only were assigned to the Hon'ble Minister.

5. Whereas in the present case, the transfer orders being issued on 04.07.2019, prima-facie, it is mid-term transfers and, therefore, there has to be compliance of approval of preceding next Competent Authority. However, perusal of file reveals that the Hon'ble Chief Minister had only approved the general / regular transfers and as regard to mid-term transfer, the Hon'ble Minister was directed to take decision at his level.

6. Thus, the position culminates that there is no approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister. Besides, after cancellation of earlier orders of transfers, the matters were not placed before the CSB for approval. The postings given to the Applicants in pursuance of earlier recommendations were totally changed. No special reasons are forthcoming to justify such mid-term transfers.

7. In view of above, I am satisfied that prima-facie, the impugned transfer order dated 04.07.2019 qua the Applicants are not sustainable and the Applicants are entitled to interim relief.

8. In view of above, implementation of the transfer order dated 04.07.2019 qua the Applicants is stayed.
9. As the Applicants have made out strong case of breach of mandatory requirement of law, the Applicants be reposted on the same post, if relieved earlier.
10. Issue notice before admission returnable on 30.07.2019.
11. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
12. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
13. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
14. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
15. In case notice is not collected within three days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

**ORDER**

1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. This is the second round of litigation wherein again there is challenge to the suspension order dated 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2018. Earlier, the Applicant has filed O.A.127/2019 which was decided by this Tribunal on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2019 whereby directions were given to take review of suspension of the Applicant in terms of G.R. dated 14.10.2011 and also to complete the D.E. within four months from the date of order.
3. As no action was taken in pursuance of direction given by the Tribunal in order dated 20.02.2019, the Applicant has again filed the present O.A.

4. During the pendency of O.A, the Competent Authority has taken review and decided to continue the suspension.
5. In so far as completion of D.E. is concerned, it is not concluded yet.
6. On the above background, the learned P.O. has filed M.A.232/2019 for extension of time to complete the enquiry. It was filed on 25.04.2019 wherein two months' time was sought for conclusion of enquiry which is in fact already over by this time but the enquiry is not progressing.
7. Thus, even if the prayer in O.A.232/2019 was granted, the period of two month as prayed in M.A. is already over. This being so, the M.A. has becomes infructuous and disposed of.
8. Today, the learned P.O. has filed short Affidavit of Smt. Vaishali Dighe, Under Secretary, G.A.D. She tried to explain the stages of enquiry. The perusal of Affidavit itself shows that the enquiry is not taken up expeditiously and longer dates are given. In fact, in terms of order passed by this Tribunal, the enquiry ought to have been expedited and adjournment should have been limited to short span of time.
9. Indeed, the Affidavit was supposed to be filed by the Enquiry Officer, who is conducting enquiry and not by Under Secretary. This shows the casual approach of the Respondent.
10. In view of above, the matter stands adjourned for final hearing at the stage of admission.

1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Shri A. J. Chougute, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. In the present O.A., the challenge is to the transfer order dated 04.07.2019 whereby the Applicant has been transferred on the post of Live Stock Development Officer (LSDO), Veterinary, Kondhwa, Dist. Pune to LSDD, Veterinary Dispensary, Grade I, Khanapur, Tal. Haveli, Dist. Pune.

3. The Applicant has challenged the impugned transfer order on the ground that it is mid-term transfer. There is no compliance of Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the Transfer Act). In the transfer order dated 04.07.2019, though the transfer is shown on request, the perusal of Minutes of the meeting of Civil Services Board reveals that the Applicant has requested for transfer at Aundh, Pune and she has not asked for Khanapur. This being the position, the transfer at Khanapur cannot be said as on request.

4. Secondly, it being the mid-term transfer, there has to be compliance of approval of preceding Competent Authority i.e. Hon'ble Chief Minister. In the present case, there is no approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister. This Tribunal has come across several Original Applications wherein order dated 04.07.2019 is under challenge. This Tribunal has granted interim relief as there being no compliance of approval of Highest Competent Authority.

5. Thus, what emerges from the record that there is no approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister to mid-term transfers dated 04.07.2019. It appears that earlier the powers of general transfer were delegated to the Secretary but it was withdrawn and Hon'ble Minister himself took over the powers. In that event also, the impugned transfer order being mid-term transfer, there has to be approval of preceding Competent Authority, as per Table attached to Section 6 of 'Transfer Act 2005', which is admittedly not complied with. This being the position, prima-facie, the impugned orders are not in accordance with the provisions of "Transfer Act 2005".




