Learned Advocate for Applicant states that request of Applicant to be transferred back to establishment of Commissioner of Police, Pune has not been considered; nonetheless Applicant has now been transferred by Order dated 30.06.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State' to establishment of 'Additional DG CID Maharashtra State Pune' and subsequently posted to 'Pune Unit'. 3. The grievance of Applicant has thus been redressed; though rather belatedly considering the fact that Applicant has 24 Year old 'Daughter' who is affected by 100% 'Mental Retardation' and suffers from 99% 'Physical Disability'. 4. The provisions of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' provide adequate 'Statutory 'Power' to 'PEB-1' and 'PEB-2' to deal with all service matters relating to 'Police Personnel' which would include implementation of provisions of 'Section 2(d)' of 'The Right of Personal Disability Act, 2016' when 'Police Personnel' are placed in role of 'Care Givers'. 5. The 'Home Department' as well as 'DGP, Maharashtra State' are required to be much more sensitive in dealing with all such cases of requests when made by 'Police Personnel' on grounds of extreme 'Personal Hardships'. 6. considered afresh based on 'Fresh Representation' which he has submitted on 08.06.2024 to now seek transfer to post of 'API' in any 'Specialized Agency' with headquarters located in 'Konkan-II Division'. The 'Fresh Representation' of Applicant submitted on 08.06.2024 therefore be considered at the earliest by 'PEB-2'; notwithstanding proposal already submitted to 'Home Department' on 19.06.2024. The 'PEB-2' may transfer Applicant to post of 'API' in any 'Specialized Agency' with headquarters in 'Konkan- II Division', so that he can subsequently be posted to 'Field Unit' of 'Specialized Agency' at 'Nashik'.

4. The attention of 'Law officer' present on behalf of 'DGP, Maharashtra States' is thereafter drawn to case of Applicant in O.A. No. 1535/2024 who is 'Police Inspector' and seeking transfer to establishment of 'SP, Nanded' within jurisdiction of 'Spl IGP Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar' on grounds of 'Husband and Wife' to be posted together; as 'Wife' of Applicant is 'Police Head Constable' in establishment of 'SP Nanded'. No reasons can be justifiable enough as to why request of Applicant was not considered when the Order dated 30.06.2024 were issued by 'DGP, Maharashtra State' to transfer based on requests about 125 'Police Inspectors'. Against this backdrop 'DGP, Maharashtra State' would now be expected to take decision about request of Applicant without any further delay as this has now matured into stark instance of request of 'Husband and Wife' to be posted together not considered even though both are serving in 'Police Administration'.

5. The O.A. No. 1534/2023 and O.A. No. 1535/2023 adjourned to 29.07.2024 for implementation of directions by 'DGP, Maharashtra State'.

Learned P.O. seeks more time to obtain specific information with respect of this substantive issue which relates to 'non-partisan' implementation directions in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024' by 'Urban Development Department'.</p>

4. The 'Urban Development Department' thus informed to examine in depth how they intend to implement directions in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024' considering the fact that several 'Municipal Commissioner, Additional Municipal Commissioner, Deputy Municipal Commissioner' who have been appointed by 'Municipal Corporations' may have been serving on their present posts for more than '3 Years' and come within ambit of directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 18.03.2024'. Hence, overall it is quite evident that implementation of direction in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024' was '*prima-faice*' was not done in 'non-partisan' manner; may be inadvertently by 'Urban Development Department' during 'General Elections Lok Sabha: 2024'.

5. The 'Urban Development Department' is to therefore convey what course of action they now intend to take in respect of Applicant who is now serving on post of 'Additional Municipal Commissioner, Parbhani Municipal Corporation'. However in interest of justice and for clarity about non-discriminatory implementation of direction in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 18.03.2024' in both letter and spirit it is necessary at this stage to direct 'Urban Development Department' to keep 'One Post' of 'Deputy Municipal Commissioner' vacant in 'Pimpri Chinchwad Corporation' from amongst 50% quota of 'Deputation Posts' earmarked for cadre of 'Chief Officer, Class-A'.
