- 5. The learned C.P.O. to verify the position whether the post of Mr. Suraj Suresn Belekar as on today is vacant.

- 1. Heard Shri B.A Bandiwadekar, learned advocate for the applicant and Ms Swati Manchekar, learned C.P.O for the Respondents.
- 2. The applicant challenges the order dated 19.4.2021 and 1.6.2021 passed by Respondents no 1 & 2 to reinstate the applicant and giving reappointment in the post of Medical Officer.
- 3. The applicant was appointed as Medical Officer on 16.1.2009 temporarily and he continued to work as Medical Officer at different places. The last appointment was given to him from 11.4.2018 to 10.3.2019. However, unfortunately, he was prosecuted for the offences under 376 (e) and 509 of I.P.C. in C.R No. 82/2018 registered on 5.12.2018. The applicant was taken into custody and remained in Jail from 6.12.2018 to 13.2.2019.
- 4. The Hon'ble Bombay High Court granted him bail on 13.2.2019 and the next day he was released. His services was terminated by order dated 21.2.2019. Thereafter the Hon'ble High Court quashed and set aside the impugned FIR by order dated 25.11.2019. The applicant moved the Respondent-State by application dated 18.2.2020, 28.2.2020, 25.3.2020 and 16.3.2021.
- 5. Dr. Gauri Rathod, Deputy Director, Health Services, Thane, based on the representation of the applicant, has submitted the report to the Commissioner, National Rural Health Mission, that the order be issued for appointment of the applicant. However, on 19.4.2021, the Commissioner, National Rural Health Mission, refused to reinstate him on the applicant that the applicant has misbehaved when he was in service. Thereafter, by order dated 18.5.2021 Deputy Director, Public Health Services also communicated the said decision to the applicant, which is subject matter of challenge in this Original Application.
- 6. When the matter appeared on Board on 3.8.2021 the Tribunal has noted that the applicant had served as ad hoc Medical Officer for 11 years from 2008 to 2019 and the FIR is quashed by the Hon'ble High Court, Bombay. Thus, there is no offence against the applicant pending.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 7. Learned counsel for the applicant pointed out that the Government has issued Notification dated 11.1.2019 to give one time absorption/regularization to the temporary Medical Officers. However, the applicant at the relevant time was in Jail though his services was terminated subsequently. The case of the applicant was not considered by the Director, Health Services on the ground that he has misbehaved while he was in service.
- 8. We have specifically noted that the applicant is not only acquitted, but the FIR itself is quashed and set aside by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court. Thus in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Government is to take decision in respect of the applicant about his reinstatement and absorption in service in view of the Notification issued by the Government dated 11.1.2019. The Government cannot sit in appeal against the order dated 25.11.2019 of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court.
- Learned C.P.O has informed that a fresh proposal of reinstating and absorbing the applicant is now put up before the Respondents and sometime be given to take decision on it.'
- 10. Hence, we grant three weeks' time to the Respondents to take appropriate decision in the case of the applicant in view of the order passed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court and also in view of the Notification dated 11.1.2019 issued by the Government.
