Learned Advocates for the Applicants states that the M.P.S.C. is likely to recommend the names of 20 Selected Candidates who are Primary Teachers of Zilla Parishad on the basis of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for the post of Deputy Education Officer but have not been declared as 'Ineligible' as per the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No.8243 of 2019 dated 15.09.2023.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for 'Interveners' proposes to file M. A. to join 5 Selected Candidates who are from amongst these 20 Selected Candidates</p> <p>4. Learned P.O. requested for time to file 'Affidavit in Reply' on behalf of Respondents.</p> <p>5. The Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.8243 of 2019, by order dated 15.09.2023 has declared that Primary Teacher of Zilla Parishads are not eligible to appear for the Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for the post of Deputy Education Officer and accordingly 54 Selected Candidates declared as "Ineligible". Therefore, against this background M.P.S.C. is directed not to recommend the -</p>

names of these 20 'Selected Candidates' who are Primary Teachers of Zilla Parishad for appointment to the post of 'Deputy Education Officer.'

Learned P.O. states that 'Revenue and Forest Department' had earlier based on the representation of the Applicant dated 23.03.2023 proposed to G.A.D that the request of the Applicant be considered, as he is 'Care-Giver' to 100% 'Blind Child' and in that proposal even referred to the guidelines issued by Government of India Department of Personnel & Training Memorandum F.No.42011/3/2014-Estt (Res) dated 08.10.2018. However, as they were advised by G.A.D. to follow the provisions of 'Divisional Cadre Structure and Divisional Cadre Allotment for direct appointment by nomination to the post of Group 'A' and Group 'B' (Gazetted and Non-Gazetted) of the Government of Maharashtra Rules, 2010 'the 'Revenue and Forest Department' issued 'Transfer Orders' of 05.06.2023 of the Applicant to post him to 'Nagpur Division' as 'Deputy Collector (Land Acquisition), Gosekhurd Project, Nagpur.'</p>

However, in the above context, it appears that though expected 'Revenue and Forest Department' had not forwarded the copy of the Order passed on 29.09.2023 to 'General Administration Department'. On query, learned PO as well as learned Advocate for the Applicant stated that the Order passed on 29.09.2023 had been forthwith communicated to viz. Learned Advocate for the Applicant points out that the Order of the Medical Education and Research, dated 13.07.2023 giving 'Additional Charge' of the post of 'Director' of Medical Education and Research Directorate, Mumbai' to the Applicant does not mention about Respondent No.2 proceeding on 'Medical Leave' as the reason for the change in 'Additional Charge'. Also, the subsequent Order of Medical Education and Drugs Department, dated 21.09.2023 does not mention that 'Additional Charge' is being changed again as the Respondent No.2 has returned from 'Medical Leave'. She states that both the orders have been issued on 'Administrative Grounds'.</p>

3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that by G.A.D. G.R. dated 05.09.2018, guidelines have been laid down which requires that wherever possible it be given to Government Servant from the same cadre based on 'Seniority Criteria' with consideration to be given to 'Experience' and 'Performance' of such Government Servant. However, when such Government Servant is not available in the same cadre then Government Servant from the immediate subordinate cadre based on 'Seniority Criteria' being given 'Additional Charge'. However, if 'Additional Charge' is not given based on 'Seniority Criteria,' then reasons have to be recorded by the 'Competent Authority'.

4. Learned Advocate for the Respondent No.2, therefore, states that it is important to know the reasons why the 'Additional Charge' of the post of 'Director' of Medical Education and Research Directorate, Mumbai' was given to Respondent No.2. The Respondent No.2 was given initially about Two Years back and he has held that 'Additional Charge' continuously till he had proceeded on 'Medical Leave' resulting in the 'Additional Charge' being given to Applicant by order dated 13.07.2023 which was rescinded by Order dated 29.07.2023 giving it back to the Respondent No.2. The learned Advocate of the Respondent No.2 stated that O.A No.1226 of 2023 is not maintainable on the grounds of 'Acquiescence,' 'Delay' and 'Laches' and also produced relevant judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and Hon'ble High Courts.

5. Learned P.O. for the Respondent seeks time to file 'Affidavit in Reply.' Learned Advocate for Respondent No.2 also wants to file 'Affidavit in Reply' for which he is granted Two Weeks.
