- Affidavit-in-Reply is filed by the respondents. Learned P.O. submits that there is no documentary evidence to support the reasons advanced by the applicant.
- The punishment awarded was to the extent of effecting the carrier of the present applicant permanently and in that view of the matter, if the appeal is itself heard on merit no loss could occur to the Respondents State.
- The Original Application is allowed with no order as to costs. The decision of the Divisional Commissioner, Exb. 'A', page 10 is set aside. Delay is hereby condoned. The Divisional Commissioner is directed to hear the appeal itself on its own merit as early as possible.
