promotion to the cadre of District Health Officer pursuant to the Departmental Promotional Committee Meeting dated 13.4.2018 till the consideration of the applicant's claim to the extent of applicants."

Interim relief granted earlier by this Tribunal has been continued thereafter.

4. Shri A.S. Deshmukh, learned Advocate holding for Shri Vivek V. Ingle, learned Advocate for respondent No. 4 has filed his affidavit on 23rd October, 2018 (Page Nos. 87 to 102). He submits that the applicants have produced the certificates issued by an institute, which is not recognized and, therefore, they are not qualified for promotion. Deliberately the present Original Application is kept lingering and respondent No. 4 and similarly other located employees / persons are being prevented from being considered for promotion.

5. Respondents No. 1 to 3 have filed their affidavit in reply on 23rd October, 2018 (Page Nos. 103 to 114). This affidavit also confirms that the diploma being claimed by the applicants is from the derecognized institute and, therefore, the applicants are not eligible for consideration for promotion. Subsequently, respondent Nos. 1 & 2 have filed sur-rejoinder on 20th June, 2019 (Page Nos. 188 to 198). This sur-rejoinder also confirms that the applicants themselves have admitted that the diploma obtained by them is from

the institute recognized by M.M.C. and not by MCI. As such, the diploma stated is not valid. The necessary documents mentioning regarding derecognized institutes is mentioned at page No. 199 along with sur-rejoinder filed by the respondent Nos. 1 & 2.

6. Opportunity was given to the learned Advocate for the applicants to clarify why interim relief needs to be continued. However, as he is adamant in not arguing the present O.A. and stated that he is not prepared. It appears that his intention is to stall the process rather than advance the arguments.

7. In view of the facts mentioned above, interim relief granted earlier is modified as follows: -

The prayer made by the applicants would be subject to the final outcome of this Original Application. Respondent authorities may complete the process of promotion to the cadre of DHO as per rules.

8. The present case is admitted. Learned Presenting officer waives service of notice for admission on behalf of the respondents.
