- 2. This O.A. is filed seeking relief of quashing and setting aside the impugned show cause notice dated 09-07-2021 (Annexure A-17) issued by the respondent no.4 i.e. Deputy Police Commissioner, Head Quarter-2, Naigaon, Brahan Mumbai as to why the services of the applicant should not be terminated.
- 3. The applicant in this application has further sought interim relief of stay to the said impugned show cause notice and seeking direction against the respondents not to take adverse action against the applicant based on the said show cause notice. The applicant claims to be a Sport Person. He has been appointed on the post of Police Constable vide appointment letter dated 02-02-2019 (Annexure A-8) from Sports Category. As per G.R. dated 01-07-2016 (Annexure A-2) issued by the School Education and Sports Department of Government of Maharashtra 5% reservation in Government and semi Government services to the Sports Persons is made available.

The applicant was appointed from the said Sports Category on the basis of merit Certificate No.18 (Annexure A-3) and Sports Certificate issued in Form No.3 dated 20-09-2017 (Annexure A-4), both issued by Maharashtra Amateur Trampoline Association and Sports Verification/Validity Certificate dated 15-11-0217 (Annexure A-6) issued by respondent no.7 i.e. Deputy Director, Sports and Youth Services, Aurangabad Division, Aurangabad.

- 4. The applicant has served for about 2 years since then on the post after being appointed as per the appointment letter dated 02-02-2019 (Annexure A-8). It is the contention of the applicant that surprisingly he received letter dated 10-08-2020 (Annexure A-9) from the respondent no.7. It was noticed by the respondent no.7 that Sports Certificate relied upon by the applicant is bogus though verification certificate was issued. In view of the same, this show cause notice was issued for hearing. Respondent no.7 thereafter issued order dated 16-09-2020 (Annexure A-10) cancelling the earlier validity certificate issued by it. According to the applicant said order is unreasonable and unsustainable.
- 5. The applicant challenged the said order dated 16-09-2020 by preferring Writ Petition No.6702/2020 (Annexure A-12) before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay Bench at Aurangabad. On 03-02-2021, said Writ

Petition came to be disposed of with liberty to the applicant to file appeal before Joint Director of Sports and Youth Services, Pune, so also the interim relief which was granted earlier in favour of the applicant was continued for 15 days.

- 6. Thereafter, the applicant preferred first appeal before the Joint Director, Sports and Youth Services, Pune on 10-02-2021 (Annexure-A-13). During the pendency of the said first appeal, the applicant preferred Writ Petition No.3338/2021 for continuation of interim relief granted earlier as per order dated 03-02-2021 (Annexure-A-12). Said Writ Petition was disposed of on 18-02-2021 (Annexure A-14) extending interim relief passed in favour of the applicant in earlier Writ Petition decided by order dated 03-02-2021 till the decision by the Joint Director, Sports and Youth Services in Appeal filed by the applicant. The first appellate authority i.e. Joint Director, Sports and Youth Services, Pune by order dated 12-03-2021 (Annexure A-15) dismissed the said appeal. According to the applicant said order is passed without supplying the necessary documents, without framing specific charges and without following the principles of natural justice.
- 7. Being aggrieved by the said order, the applicant has preferred the second appeal dated 08-07-2021 (Annexure A-16) before the respondent no.5. The Commissioner, Sports and Youth Services, Pune as per the provisions of

- G.R. dated 01-07-2016. The applicant has applied for interim stay before the said authority on 07-07-2021, copy of which is at page 169-A to 169-C of the paper book, collectively.
- 8. In the meanwhile, the impugned show cause notice dated 09-07-2021 (Annexure A-17) is issued by the respondent no.4 (which is wrongly stated as respondent no.5 by the applicant in O.A.) thereby directing the applicant as to why his services should not be terminated as the Sports Validity Certificate relied upon by the applicant is invalidated.
- 9. Learned Advocate for the applicant submits that the applicant has completed about 2 years' service and the impugned show cause notice is issued without following due process and principles of natural justice and if further action is taken pursuant to the said show cause notice adversely purpose of Original Application is likely to be defeated.
- 10. Learned CPO opposed the said submissions stating that the respondents have come across a situation wherein the employment under Sports Category is obtained by presenting bogus certificate and as such sought time for filing detailed affidavit in reply in the matter.
- 11. The facts as stated above show that during the pendency of the first appeal before the Joint Director,

Sports and Youth Services, Pune in respect of order dated 16-09-2020 (Annexure A-10) issued by the respondent no.7 thereby cancelling the earlier verification/validity certificate dated 15-11-2017 (Annexure A-6) issued by the respondent no.7, interim relief of protection was granted to the applicant by the Hon'ble High Court and that was operative till decision of the first appeal. Record shows that the applicant has now preferred second appeal. In the said second appeal along with application for stay is pending. Meanwhile, impugned show cause notice dated 09-07-2021 (Annexure A-17) is issued. This Tribunal is required to consider the legality of the said order in the O.A. Hence, if interim relief to the extent of not passing adverse orders against the applicant is not granted then very purpose of filing O.A. is likely to be defeated. Moreover, the applicant has completed tenure of about 2 years and the Tribunal is required to consider in the facts and circumstances of the case what course is available to the respondents to deal with the subject matter.

12. In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause 36-C to the extent of not taking any adverse action against the applicant pursuant to impugned show cause notice dated 09-07-2021 issued by the respondent no.4 is granted till filing reply of the respondents.

- 13. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 27.08.2021.
- 14. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 15. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

- 2. Learned Advocate for the applicant seeks interim relief to the effect of stay to the execution and implementation of order of transfer of the applicant dated 04-06-2021.
- 3. It is the case of the applicant that she was working as Staff Nurse with respondent no.4 at Latur. By the impugned order dated 04-06-2021 (Annexure A-1), the applicant has been transferred on promotion to Sub District Hospital, Daryapur, Dist. Amrawati. The applicant states that she is facing hardship due to the said transfer Her husband is working as Village Development Officer (VDO) at PanchayatSamiti, Ausa. Her children are studying in 10th and 12th standard, respectively. She made representation dated 08-06-2021 (Annexure A-2) [wrongly stated as dated 06-06-2021) seeking transfer in Latur only. She has stated that she would accept the promotion only if she is posted within a sphere of 30 km. from Latur district or else she would refuse the promotion itself.

- 4. Learned P.O. opposed the submissions advanced on behalf of the applicant and sought time to file affidavit in reply.
- 5. Upon enquiry to the learned Advocate for the applicant whether the applicant has joined the transferred post or not, he has submitted that the applicant has not joined at the transferred place.
- 6. Considering the nature of the representation dated 08-06-2021 (Annexure A-2), in my considered opinion, this is not a fit case to grant interim or ad-interim relief staying the transfer order. Hence, prayer for interim relief is rejected. *Prima facie*, there is nothing on record to show that the transfer order is passed in contravention of any of the provisions relating to promotional transfer.
- 7. Hence, issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 13.08.2021.
- 8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
