	3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant relies on the G.R. dated 06.02.2019 by which remuneration given to Kotwal is increased. The Applicant is receiving remuneration of Rs.15,000/- as Kotwal because he was eligible for promotion. In the order issued by the Collector, Sindhudurg the name of the Applicant Mr. Milind Narayan Kadam from Kankavli is mentioned and his educational qualification is mentioned as 10 <sup>th</sup> Standard and thereafter he was getting remuneration of Rs.15,000/- per month. Thereafter, seniority list was prepared and published on 20.06.2022 wherein the name of the Applicant appeared in the list of Kotwal. In the said impugned order the applicant was held ineligible.
	4. Learned Advocate submits that on 30.09.2022 the order was issued by the Deputy

Collector holding that applicant is not eligible for promotion. Subsequently, there is another order passed by the Collector, Sindhudurg on the same date that as the Applicant is not eligible because he has passed 9<sup>th</sup> standard therefore, the amount which is earlier paid is to be recovered. Learned Advocate submits that the name of Respondent No.8 does not appear in the list dated 29.05.2022. However, he was appointed in the place of the applicant therefore he has challenged the appointment of Respondent No.8 in this O.A.

5. Learned P.O. submits that the certificate which is relied by the applicant in respect of his educational qualification is from Yashwantrao Chavan Mukt Vidyapith and only in respect of preparatory certificate. It is of passing 9<sup>th</sup> standard and for eligibility the candidate is required to pass 10<sup>th</sup> standard. Therefore, the applicant has to stand on his own legs and prove his case.

6. Prima facie, the applicant is not eligible and therefore taking objection on the appointments of Respondents No.3 to 8 is relevant and the applicant has no locus. Hence, no case is made out to grant interim relief.

7. Adjourned 01.02.2023. For learned P.O. to file affidavit and for further submissions.

#### ORDER

1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Ms S. P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. The Applicant has challenged the order dated 06.01.2023 issued by the Respondent No.2 whereby the Applicant is relieved from the establishment of Respondent No.2 where she was on deputation for three years.

3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant sought interim relief *inter-alia* contending that since the Applicant was on deputation for the period of three years in pursuance of order dated 14.10.2021 issued by the Respondent No.1- Government, in case the deputation period has to be curtailed for one or other reason, the competent authority is Respondent No.1 and impugned action of relieving the Applicant by the Respondent No.2 unilaterally is unsustainable in law.

4. Per contra, learned C.P.O. opposes interim relief contending that performance of the Applicant in deputation period found totally unsatisfactory and there were several lapses in discharging of duties on deputation. She submits that the Board of Governance had empowered

17

the Director General of Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Research and Training Institute (BARTI), Pune and it is in pursuance of it, the Applicant came to be relieved.

5. The issue of deputation is governed by Rule 40 read with Appendix 2 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Joining Time, Foreign Service and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal), Rules, 1981 to be read along with G.R. dated 17.12.2016 issued by the Government. As per Rule 40 read with Appendix 2, the terms and conditions of deputation to foreign services shall be strictly in accordance with rules and no departure from the prescribed terms and conditions shall be permissible. The perusal of G.R. dated 17.12.2016, Clause D of sub-clause 5 specifically provides that where borrowing authority felt necessity to curtail deputation period in that event borrowing authority has to send the proposal to that effect to the concerned department to which Government servant belongs and three months prior notice is required for curtailing deputation. However, in case of irregularity, misappropriation and misconduct etc. for the reasons to be recorded, the deputation period can be curtailed with immediate effect.

6. Whereas in present case, it is borrowing authority i.e. BARTI unilaterally relieved the Applicant which *prima-facie* not in consonance with Rules and G.R. dated 17.12.2016. The Governing Counsel cannot use such powers in defiance of Rules and the borrowing authority was required to send proposal to the Respondent No.1/parent department of the Applicant for necessary orders to curtail deputation. However, appropriate procedure as required under Rule and G.R. dated 17.12.2016 is not followed and the Applicant is relieved unilaterally. Notably, impugned order reveals that BARTI made correspondence with the Government in this behalf but Government (Respondent No.1) did not respond it in any manner.

7. Ex-facie, the powers vest with the Respondent No.1 to curtail deputation. The impugned order passed by the Respondent No.2 is thus *prima-facie* without jurisdiction and not in accordance to law and required to be stayed.

8. For the aforesaid reasons, interim relief as prayed in Clause 10(a) is granted.

9. The office objection, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.

10. Issue notice before admission returnable on 14.02.2023.

11. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

12. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

13. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

14. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the Original/<u>Miscellaneous</u> Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Benches under the caption "<u>for Dismissal</u>" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original / <u>Miscellaneous</u> Application shall stand dismissed.
