Learned P.O. states that 'District Collector, Kolhapur' having considered the directions given on 13.12.2023 has expressed deep reservations by letter dated 07.01.2024 about considering the request submitted by Applicant to convey as follows "<i>Despite considering the whole matter with open mind as per the directions of Hon. MAT, there is no administratively suitable post for her due to all reasons mentioned earlier in the affidavits in post hearings and unsuitably of her. Hon. MAT is requested to avoid setting a wrong precedence for the service matters and is requested to close the matter.</i>"</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant has challenged the 'Transfer Order' dated 12.01.2024 issued by the 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' against backdrop 'General Election to Loksabha: 2024' by which Applicant who was serving on the post of 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2), Pune' has been transferred to the post of 'Police Inspector Control Room, Pune'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant contends that the 'Transfer Order' dated 12.01.2024 has been based on recommendation made by 'P.E.B. wherein 'Additional Police Commissioner (Administration) Pune' has also signed as 'Deputy Commissioner of Police, Pune (HQ)' who is designated as 'Member Secretary' of 'P.E.B.'.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that 'Section 22 (N) (c) of 'The Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' does not use the phrase 'at one place of posting' as under 'Section 22 N (1) (b) but instead provides for 'Fixed Tenure' of 'Three Years' in 'Crime Branch' or 'Special Branch' on establishments of 'Commissioner of Police'.</p> <p align="right">[P.T.O.]</p>

The Applicant had never been served any 'Memo' by 'Commissioner of Police, Pune'. Further no opportunity was given to him to submit explanation about contents of the 'Default Report' submitted by 'Assistant Commissioner of Police, (Crime Unit-2), Pune' on 10.01.2024 which came to be forthwith forwarded by 'D.C.P. Crime, Pune' to 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' on 10.01.2024 as just prior to meeting of 'P.E.B.' held on 12.01.2024.</p> <p>6. Learned P.O. refers to copy of letter received from 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' dated 16.01.2024 which mentions that it was urgently required to transfer Applicant from the post of 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2), Pune'. The 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' has also forwarded copy of 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'P.E.B.' held on 12.01.2024.</p> <p>7. Learned P.O. also produced copy of the 'Default Report' submitted by the 'Assistant Commissioner of Police, Pune City' on 10.01.2024 and which cause to be forwarded immediately by 'Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime Pune' on 10.01.2024 to 'Commissioner of Police, Pune'.</p> <p>8. Learned Advocate for Respondent No.4 states that she has been transferred from the post of 'Police Inspector Crime' in 'Police Station Faras Khana, Pune' to the post of 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2), Pune' which was held by Applicant on account of completion of tenure of more than '3 Years' in last of '4 Years' as per guidelines in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 regarding 'General Election of Lok Sabha 2024' which is accordingly also recorded in 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'P.E.B.' held on 12.01.2024. The Applicant has been transferred before the completion of 'Fixed Tenure' of '3 Years' as provided under 'Section 22N1(c) of Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' primarily on the ground that 'Default Report' had been submitted by his immediate 'Supervisory Officer' who is 'Assistant Commissioner of Police (Crime Unit-2) Pune' on 10.01.2024 mentioning that Applicant was not diligently performing duties being on the sensitive post of 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2), Pune'. The 'Default Report' of 'Assistant Commissioner of Police (Crime Unit-2) Pune' dated 10.01.2024 mentions about the availability of 'Cocaine' and 'Other Drugs' in 'Hookah Parlours' & 'Pubs' etc. in 'Pune City' about which Applicant was informed from time to time to take stringent action but grossly failed to act on the directions of this 'Superior Officers'.</p> <p>10. The 'Default Report' of 'Assistant Commissioner of Police (Crime Unit-2) Pune' refers to series of correspondence beginning from 03.04.2023 upto 02.01.2024 from which it may be inferred that those were also about the performance of Applicant serving as 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2)'.</p> <p>11. The 'Minutes of Meeting' of the 'P.E.B.' held on 12.01.2024 shows that most of the transfers were effected to either fill up vacant posts of 'Police Inspector' or to implement the directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 against the backdrop of 'General Transfer to Loksabha 2024'. The 'Minutes of Meeting' of P.E.B. however contains separate paragraph with reasons for immediate transfer of Applicant based on the 'Default Report', submitted by 'Assistant Commissioner of Police Pune City' on 10.01.2024 and recommendation thereupon from the 'Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime Pune' submitted on 10.01.2024 and why it then became so urgent to transfer Applicant urgently from post of 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2), Pune' to post of 'Police Inspector, Control Room, Pune.' [P.T.O.]</p>

The 'Transfer Order' dated 12.01.2024 of 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' is in respect of other 'Police Inspectors' as well related because they were to implement the directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 but only exception was made in respect of Applicant who was transferred on grounds of 'Default Report' submitted by 'Assistant Commissioner of Police Pune City' on 10.01.2024 and recommendation received thereupon from the 'Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime Pune' on 10.01.2024. Also important fact of consideration is that 'Respondent No.4' who was transferred as per directions 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 has immediately joined on the post of 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2), Pune'. Therefore grant of any 'Interim Relief' at this stage would seriously impact the overall arrangements being made by 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' to ensure conduct of free and fair 'General Elections to Loksabha 2024'.</p> <p>13. The Applicant's case is clearly not related to implementation of 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 but has been effected in 'Public Interest' and on account of 'Administrative Exigencies' under provisions 'Section 22(N) (2)' of the 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'. Further, considering that in several judgments of 'Hon'ble Supreme Court of India' and 'Hon'ble Bombay High Court' it has been held that granting 'Interim Relief' to Applicant at such stage would amount to '<i>status qua ante</i>' resulting in effect to granting of 'Interim Mandatory Injunction'. Hence, for all these particular reasons relating to transfer of Applicant on 12.01.2024, the Applicant cannot be granted 'Interim Relief' and be allowed to join back on post of 'Police Inspector Crime Branch (Anti-Narcotics Unit-2), Pune'.</p> <p>14.
