- Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant who is working as Constable is selected for the post of Police Sub-Inspector (PSI) and he was supposed to be sent for training of PSI in the batch of 119 to Maharashtra Police Training Academy, Nashik. However, by order dated Special IGP (Establishment) informed that 1.7.2021 applicant who is selected from the competitive examination of 2017 should not be sent for training as the applicant is convicted and appeal is pending before the Hon'ble High Court. Ld. Advocate for the applicant points out that Revision Application No.148 of 2021 admittedly is pending before the Hon'ble High Court. However, in that Revision the applicant has moved Interim Application No.2138 of 2021 wherein the applicant has sought stay to his conviction and it was granted by the Hon'ble High Court by its order dated 17.1.2023. Ld. Advocate submits that conviction given in trial Court and confirmed in appeal is now stayed by the Hon'ble High Court and therefore applicant can be sent for training of PSI. Ld. Advocate submits that it will take some years to decide the revision and at that time the applicant might be age barred.
- 3. Ld. CPO relies on the affidavit in reply dated 15.3.2022 filed by Arvind Ganesh Jadhav, Deputy Assistant (Establishment-II) to the DGP, MS, Mumbai on behalf of respondent no.2. Along with this affidavit the attestation form of the applicant dated 4.3.2021 is annexed. Ld. CPO pointed out relevant clause 15(1) of the said attestation form and submits that while filling up the form a query was made whether the candidate is convicted and the applicant has answered in negative though he was convicted.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 4. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant has answered in negative only because though he was convicted he was given the benefit of Section 360 of Cr.P.C. and was released on Bond. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant in clause 15(1)(c) has answered in affirmative about the criminal case against him and he has also furnished the decision dated 21.1.2019 given by JMFC, Pune in RCC No.2739/2014 where he was convicted. He did not want to suppress the fact about his prosecution.
- 5. We have considered the submissions of both the parties. The order dated 17.1.2023 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Interim Application No.2138 of 2021 is a fresh development in this matter and we direct the concerned authority in the office of Director General of Police to take into account the order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 17.1.1023, by which not only sentence but conviction is stayed, and thereafter to take decision within two weeks and communicate the same to the applicant. With these directions OA is disposed off.
