#### ORDER

1. Today, learned counsel for the applicant is present and submitted that the matter is Part Head and prayed that it may be heard at the earliest within two weeks. She submitted that the Respondents are unnecessarily seeking time to furnish the list of Directors and Joint Directors from 1995. Learned counsel for the applicant further submitted that the arguments were heard finally.

2. Learned C.P.O submits that she needs time to furnish additional information which was asked by the Tribunal. Learned C.P.O submitted that as there was stay granted by the Tribunal in favour of the applicant, the process of interview was stalled. Now, after grant of interim relief by the Tribunal on 25.2.2022, the Department has started working on the interview process. She is unable to inform how much time the Respondents will require to complete the process of interview for the said post. Till today, the date of interview is not declared by the Department.

3. The applicant has filed the present Original Application to quash the advertisement dated 10.8.2021 to the extent it does not provide reservation to the persons with disabilities as per Sec 34 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant has already argued the matter for four hours and she will require an hour to argue the matter. We at present have given priority to hear and finally decide the matters of the year 2014 as there are very few matters which are shown as pending. So the preference is given to these old matters.

5. We make it clear that the applicant at present is holding the post of Joint Director as he is promoted on a temporary basis on 3.9.2021, subsequent to the filing of the Original Application. By order dated 25.2.2022 we have directed the M.P.S.C as per para 4 to go ahead with the selection process for appointment to the post of Joint Director and the appointment to the said post by

recruitment will be subject to the outcome of this Original Application. We also permitted the applicant to participate in the said selection process.

6. Thus, we are of the view that immediate interim relief was given to the applicant. Therefore, though the learned counsel for the applicant has argued this matter for four hours, we are unable to accept the request of the learned counsel for the applicant to hear the matter finally after two weeks. However, we keep this matter for final hearing on 12.4.2022 at 12.00 noon. Learned C.P.O is directed to furnish the information called for by the Tribunal on or before 4.4.2022 and copy of the said information is to be sent by email to the learned counsel for the applicant as well as the applicant.
