- The Applicant is serving in the cadre of Talathi. By impugned order dated 05.08.2021 he was transferred from Sajja Ghot to Sajja Bhosgaon, Sub Division Patan, District Satara. In O.A. he contended that he has not completed six years tenure on the date of transfer and transfer is bad in law.
- Tribunal by order dated 02.09.2021 allowed the 3. Applicant to continue at Sajja Ghot i.e. the place from which she was transferred. Later on 19.05.2021 the Applicant made statement that the Applicant has now completed 6 years tenure and has already given options, Tribunal recorded this statement as under:-
  - In view of above submissions, I hereby revoked the said order (30.08.2021) with following directions:-

"The Applicant is allowed to give 10 options to the Respondent authority and the Respondent authority to transfer the Applicant as there is no order of stay and as the order of stay is revoked, if they

want to do so."

Thus what transpires from record that on the date of transfer order on 05.08.2021 the Applicant had completed 5 years and 2 months but he was claiming his tenure to be 6 years, and therefore the Tribunal has granted interim relief on 30.08.2021. The Applicant had also alleged that he was not given posting as per her option as per G.R. dated 09.04.2018.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 5. Now, legal position as decided by this Tribunal in earlier Group of O.As. based upon the Judgment of Hon'ble High Court that the tenure of Group 'C' employee is three years and there is no vested right to claim tenure as 6 years. Leaving aside this issue, now the Applicant has already completed more than 6 years at one place of posting. Indeed, he had completed 6 years tenure in general transfer of 2022 but in 2022 no general transfer are issued.
- 6. As stated above, Tribunal by order dated 19.05.2022 has allowed the Applicant to give 10 options which is to be acted upon the transfer of the Applicant.
- 7. In view of above, there is no point to keep O.A. pending since the Applicant has already completed normal tenure and also given options for transfer. Respondents are therefore at liberty to transfer the Applicant either in general transfer or in view of options given by her.

- 1. Heard Ms Pooja Mankoji, learned Advocate holding for Shri S.S. Dere, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. This O.A. is filed for seeking direction to the Respondent to relieve the Applicant in terms of his promotion order dated 28.04.2021.
- 3. Indeed, when this O.A. was taken up for hearing along with one connected O.A. No.826/2021, it was noticed that 530 Police Personnel were promoted to the post A.P.I. However, in clause 5 of promotion order it is sated that were Police Personnel are suspended or undergoing punishment or against whom D.E. are pending they should not be relieved in terms of promotion order and their information be sent to the office of Director General of Police for further action.
- 4. In view of above, Tribunal by order dated 25.10.2021 directed Director General of Police to explain how promotion orders are issued without verifying the factual aspects of D.E., Punishment etc.
- 5. Director General of Police filed Affidavit stating that D.E. has been already initiated against the Applicant and having noticed it by order dated 29.06.2021 direction were given not to relieve the Applicant.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 6. Later by order dated 06.12.2021 punishment of withdrawing one increment with cumulative effect for one year has been imposed.
- 7. Today, learned P.O. has tendered order passed by Director General of Police dated 16.12.2021 stating that order of promotion of Applicant has been cancelled. Order is taken on record and marked by letter 'X' for identification.
- 8. Thus promotion order dated 28.04.2021 itself is now cancelled therefore question of direction to relieve the Applicant does not survives. O.A. has become infructuous.
- 9. O.A. is therefore disposed of with no order as to costs.
