2. Present O.A. has been filed by the applicant claiming following relief:

*“9.(A) To quash and set aside orders dt.24/9/2018 (Annexure “A”) issued by resp. no.2, whereby, a composite Departmental Enquiry bearing No.724/2019 has been initiated against applicants, or in the alternative respondents may please be directed to suspend Departmental Enquiry No.724/2019 till final adjudication of Special Case No.8/2018, by passing appropriate order or direction, as the case may be.”*

3. It is the matter of record that though interim relief was also sought by the applicants thereby restraining the respondents to proceed with the departmental enquiry, the same has not been granted. It is brought to our notice that during the pendency of the O.A., the enquiry proceedings are proceeded further and the enquiry has been completed. The learned Counsel for the applicant today tendered

across the bar communication dated 20-12-2021 which is the second show cause notice. Contents of the said notice reveal that the enquiry has been completed and the punishment has also been proposed and now what remains is final decision to be taken by the disciplinary authority about the imposition of the penalty. The learned Counsel for the applicant invited our attention to the portion in the affidavit of respondent nos.1 to 5 and more particularly to the following portion:

*“11. As regards to the contents of Para No.6 (9) of the Original Application, I say that the contents of this para are not true and correct, hence it is denied by the deponent. I most humbly say that, as per the ACB spot Panchanama report dated 14.03.2017, the respondent no.1 issued charge sheet dated 24.09.2019. I further say that, till the outcome of the said ACB Special Case, the departmental enquiry will not disclose its final decision and no action will be taken. Hence, the applicant should not oppose the departmental enquiry.”*

4. Learned Counsel pointed out that in paragraph 15 of the said affidavit in reply respondents have reiterated that the departmental enquiry will not disclose its final decision and no action will be taken. Learned Counsel for the applicant further submits that the applicants will not make any attempt to prolong the decision of the criminal case.

In view of the fact that now enquiry has been completed, there seems no reason to keep the present O.A. pending and can be disposed of with following directions in view of the affidavit in reply filed by the respondent nos.1 to 5.

6. The respondents shall not take any final decision as about imposing punishment on the applicant till decision of the criminal case bearing Special Case No.08/2018 by the Special Court. O.A. stands disposed of accordingly with no order as to costs.
