3. In the circumstances, relying on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Manish Gupta & Anr. Etc. Etc. Vs. President, Jan Bhagidari Samiti & Ors. Etc. Etc., Civil Appeal Nos. 3084-3088 of 2022 (Arising out of Special Leave Petition (Civil) No. 12946-12950 of 2017) dated 21.4.2022 an interim relief was sought that ad-hoc employees cannot be substituted with another ad-hoc appointees. Relying on this this Tribunal has directed judgment the respondents not to replace or appoint or substitute the ad-hoc appointees with another ad-hoc appointees. In spite of the order passed by the Tribunal as aforesaid in the M.A. it is the contention of the applicants that in of the advertisement published pursuance the respondents have appointed all 7 Medical Officers on adhoc basis. In the circumstances, the applicants have filed the present M.As. seeking stay to the implementation of the order of appointment issued in favour of these 7 persons till interim order passed by this Tribunal is complied with by the respondents. the Misc. Applications this Tribunal has passed first order of issuance of notice.

4. When the matter was before the Office for compliance of office objections, the office has raised objection that the parties who are in the M.As. are not parties in the O.As. According to the office all these persons require to be added first as party in O.As. and without that they cannot be made party in the M.As.

5. learned counsel According to the for the applicants, the applicants are not seeking any relief against the persons, who are added as respondents in the present M.As., in the O.As. It is further contended that though these persons may be necessary parties in the M.As., there is no propriety in adding them as party respondents in the O.As. since they are not necessary parties in the O.As. nor they can fall in the term of proper parties for adjudication of that petition. The learned counsel further submitted that there is no such rule also in existence, which mandates that the person unless is party in the O.A. cannot be impleaded as party in the M.A.

6. I have duly considered the submissions advanced on behalf of the learned counsel for the applicants. It

appears to me that insofar as the prayers made in the M.As. are concerned, the persons who are appointed as ad-hoc Medical Officers are certainly necessary parties for the reason that these persons are likely to be adversely affected, if any, order is passed in favour of the applicants in the M.As. However, insofar as the O.As. are concerned, therein the applicants are praying for their regularization on the basis of the continuous services rendered by these applicants for years together. While regularizing the services of the applicants consideration will be the period of service rendered by these applicants with the respondents on ad-hoc basis. Having regard to the relief, which is claimed in the O.As., it does not appear to me that the persons, who were not in employment of the respondents at the relevant time, who are now appointed as fresh for first time as has been contended by the applicants may not be necessary parties in the O.As.

7. In the circumstances, the applicants cannot be insisted to make the persons, who are made respondents in the present M.As. as respondents in the O.As. also. Office is directed not to insist for making the applicants as party respondents in the O.As. and act upon the
