2. It is the grievance of the applicant that his suspension has been continued by the respondents beyond 90 days without taking any proper review of the suspension order dated 4.1.2021 till today.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the applicant relying on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Ajay Kumar Chaudhari Vs. Union of India and others, Civil Appeal No. 1912/2015 (Arising out of SLP No. 31761 of 2013 decided on 15.2.2015), submitted that in view of the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the aforesaid judgment the order of suspension cannot be sustained beyond the period of 90 days, if no review has been taken of the said order.

4. Learned counsel pointed out that the order of suspension passed against the applicant is shown to have been reviewed by the Review Committee and on the oral instructions of the said committee the period of suspension of the applicant is stated to be continued. Learned counsel invited my attention to the letter dated 13.2.2023 received to respondent No. 2 from respondent No. 4 and submitted that such course is impermissible.

5. Learned Chief Presenting Officer has resisted the contentions raised on behalf of the applicant. Reiterating the contentions raised in the affidavit in reply, learned C.P.O. submitted that there are serious charges against the applicant making out the offences punishable Under Sections 406, 408, 420, 468, 469 & 471 and financial implications are involved. Learned C.P.O. in the circumstances prayed for rejecting the request of the applicant.

6. I have carefully considered the submissions advanced on behalf of the applicant and the respondent authorities. I have also perused the documents filed on record.

7. The Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of **Ajay Kumar Chaudhari Vs. Union of India and others** (cited supra) has issued certain guidelines. The relevant paragraph of the said judgment reads thus:

> "14 We, therefore, direct that the currency of a Suspension Order should not extend beyond three months if within this period the Memorandum of Charges/Chargesheet is not served on the delinquent officer/employee; if the Memorandum of Charges/Chargesheet is served a reasoned order must be passed for the extension of the suspension. As in the case in hand, the Government is free to transfer the concerned person to any Department in any of its offices within or outside the State so as to sever any local or personal contact that he may have and which he may misuse for obstructing the investigation against him. The Government may also prohibit him from contacting any person, or handling records and documents till the stage of his having to prepare his defence. We think this will adequately safeguard the universally recognized principle of human dignity and the right to a speedy trial and shall also preserve the interest of the Government in the prosecution. We recognize that previous Constitution Benches have been reluctant to quash proceedings on the grounds of delay, and to set time limits to their duration. However, the imposition of a limit on the period of suspension has not been discussed in prior case law, and would not be contrary to the interests of justice. Furthermore, the direction of the Central Vigilance Commission that pending a criminal investigation departmental proceedings are to be held in abevance stands superseded in view of the stand adopted by us."

8. As has been laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court the review committee is supposed to take a decision whether conscious to revoke the suspension or to continue it further and also is required to record reasons for continuing the suspension and the period therefor. In the present matter though the learned C.P.O. has submitted that the review has been taken by the review committee, it has to be stated that there cannot be oral order from the review committee. Review committee has to take a conscious decision and record its reasons in writing. Oral instructions cannot be taken into account. The fact remains that there is no document or information on record evidencing that the review committee has reviewed the order of suspension passed against the applicant. In the circumstances, it appears to me that the present O.A. can be disposed of by giving following directions. Hence, the following order: -

<u>O R D E R</u>

The respondents are directed to keep the present matter before the competent review

committee and the said committee shall review the order passed on 4.1.2021 within 4 weeks from the date of this order in light of the law laid down in the case of Ajay Kumar Choudhari (cited supra) and shall pass a reasoned order. It need not be stated that the order passed by the Review Committee can be subject matter of scrutiny before this Tribunal.

There shall be no order as to costs.
