

- 2. The Applicant has challenged notice dated 07.01.2022 issued by Respondent No.1 Commissioner of Police, Mumbai thereby directing the Applicant to vacate the quarter and also to pay penal charges.
- 3. The Applicant's mother was working as sweeper on the establishment of Respondent No.1 and died in harness on 16.09.2021. After her death the Applicant was appointed on compassionate ground as sweeper by order dated 03.01.2022. While the Applicant's mother was in service, quarter was allotted to her which is now occupied by the Applicant.
- 4. By G.R. dated 20.04.2002, Government has taken policy decision to transfer service quarter in the name of heir of deceased Government servant and on that basis the Applicant has made Application dated 11.01.2022 for transfer of quarter in his name. However instead of taking necessary steps, impugned notice for eviction is issued.
- 5. *Prima-facie*, the Applicant seems to be entitled for transfer of quarter in his name in terms of G.R. dated 20.04.2002. Respondent therefore should not take any coercive steps for eviction till the decision of O.A.
