1. Heard Smt Punam Mahajan, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. Learned Advocate for Applicant narrated the case of another officer who is also an 'Assistant Commissioner of Police' and was posted together along with Applicant in 'Control Room Thane City' on 24.11.2023 in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane' and subsequently both came to be posted together once again as 'A.C.P., Traffic Branch' by 'Transfer Order' dated 31.01.2024 of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane' issued under provisions of 'Section 22N' of the 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'

3. Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that the facts about Applicant and the other 'Assistant Commissioner of Police' are identical as they both were serving on 'Temporary Charges' as per Office Orders dated 24.11.2023 and 21.01.2024 of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane'. The only distinguishing factor in case of Applicant was that in between 'Commissioner of Police, Thane' on 30.11.2023 had also given 'Temporarily Charge' to Applicant of the 'Vacant Post' of 'Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalva Division, Thane City'.

4. Learned P.O. on other hand states that the 'Transfer Order' dated 07.03.2024 of 'Home Department' to transfer Applicant from post of 'Assistant Commissioner of Police' in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane' to establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai' was on the basis of the fact that he was holding 'Substantive Charge' of the post of 'Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalva Division, Thane City' which was related to making 'Security Arrangements' and involved with 'Deployment of Forces' and because Applicant was serving in 'Home District'.

5. The 'Transfer Order' dated 07.03.2024 of 'Home Department' thus appears to have been issued with reference to 'Office Order' of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane' dated 30.11.2023 by which Applicant was given only 'Temporary Charge' of post of 'Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalva Division, Thane City'.

However, this is not borne out by the facts which have now emerged because no 'Transfer Orders' had been issued in respect of Applicant to post him as 'Assistant Commissioner of Police, Kalva Division, Thane City' under 'Section 22N' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' prior to 'Transfer Order' dated 31.01.2024 of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane'. On the other hand, learned Advocate for Applicant also produced documents to indicate Applicant had in fact drawn his 'Salary & Allowance' for month of 'January: 2024' as 'Assistant Commissioner of Police' while serving in 'Control Room, Thane City' which would naturally mean that at the time of issue of directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 the Applicant was indeed serving on 'Temporary Charge' in 'Control Room, Thane City'.

6. The facts and circumstances of the case of Applicant also speaks volumes about effectiveness of 'Police Administration', if liberal options continue to be exercised in the form of 'Temporary Charges' assigned to 'Senior Police Officers' such as 'Assistant Commissioners of Police'. Hence, it becomes compelling case to give directions that Applicant be permitted to forthwith join back in 'Control Room, Thane City' and hold 'Additional Charge' of the post of 'Assistant Commissioner of Police, Traffic Branch, Thane City' where he was serving as per 'Transfer Order' dated 31.01.2024 of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane' at the time of issue of Transfer Order dated 07.03.2024 of 'Home Department'.

7. The 'Home Department' can be fairly expected that whenever transfers of 'Senior Police Officers' such as 'Assistant Commissioner of Police' are proposed by 'C.S.B.' and subsequently approved by 'Competent Authority'; complete factual information must be obtained from (i) 'Commissioners of Police' and (ii) 'Superintendents of Police' through 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' including about all posts which are held by them as (i) 'Substantive Charge' and / or (ii) 'Additional Charges' before 'Statutory Powers' are exercised by 'Competent Authority' under 'Section 22N' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'.

Learned PO thereupon states that Transfer Order dated 23.02.2024 of Rural Development Department Order was issued based on recommendations of 'C.S.B.' which held its meeting on 06.02.2024 and 16.02.2024.</p> <p>4. The learned PO in aforesaid context is thus informed to find out from (i) 'Rural Development Department' and (ii) 'District Collector, Satara' as to what course of action they intend to take in all fairness for non-partisan implementation of the direction in Election Commission of India by letter dated 21.12.2023 only in respect of Applicant who has been posted as 'B.D.O. Panchayat Samiti, Shirol, District Kolhapur' by Transfer Order dated 23.02.2024 of Rural Development Department, because of asymmetry of information placed before 'C.S.B.' in its meetings held on 06.02.2024 and 16.02.2024.</p> <p>5. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant, Shri A.D. Gugale, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents. Shri S.S. Thorat, lerned Advocate on behalf of Respondent No.4 is not present. 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant had been assigned work of 'Nodal Officer' – 'Implementing MCC Law and Order' as per letter of 'Dy CEO (GAD) ZP, Satara' dated 16.01.2024 addressed to 'Under Secretary Rural Development Department'. However, this assignment of Applicant was subsequently cancelled by 'Dy CEO (GAD) ZP, Satara' letter dated 06.02.2024 which was also addressed to 'Under Secretary Rural Development Department'. 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that as per 'Assistant Returning Officer, '45-Satara PC' Order dated 14.02.2024 Applicant has now been assigned work relating to 'Postal Ballot Papers/ Dummy Ballot Papers' but only in the capacity of 'Team Member' under 'SDO, Koregaon, District Satara' who is 'Nodal Officer'. 4. Learned PO states that Rural Development Department Development Order dated 23.02.2024 was issued as per recommendations of 'C.S.B.' which held its meetings on 06.02.2024 and 16.02.2024. 5. The learned PO in the aforesaid context is informed to find out from (i) 'Rural Development <p style="text-align: right;">[P.T.O.]</p>

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Department' and (ii) 'District Collector, Satara' as to what they intend to do about the case of Applicant who has been transferred to post of 'Deputy Chief Executive Officer' (EGS) in office of 'Divisional Commissioner Office, Pune' as per Transfer Order dated 23.02.2024 of Rural Development Department because of asymmetry of factual information placed before 'C.S.B.' in its meetings held on 06.02.2024 and 16.02.2024.

6. The learned PO must also ascertain from 'Rural Development Department' about why different stands are taken by them as 'Cadre Controlling Authority'; as is becomes evident from 'Para 8' of the 'Affidavit-in-Reply' filed on 13.03.2024. The contents of 'Para 8' of the 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 13.03.2024 indicates that in respect of those officers from cadre of 'BDO's in 'Satara District' in respect of whom 'Hon'ble Minister, In-Charge' of 'Rural Development Department' had given certain directions; their transfers were placed on reconsideration of 'C.S.B.' and then upon even cancelled by 'Rural Development Department'. Further the contents of 'Para 10' of 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 13.03.2024 filed in O.A. No. 256 of 2024 reveals that some 'B.D.O.'s who are serving 'ZP, Kolhapur' on the other hand were exempted on grounds of having been assigned duties of 'Sector Officers' which are as per directions in 'Para 6.3' of Election Commission of India by letter dated 21.12.2023.

Punam Mahajan, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.D. Gugale, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents. 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant emphasized on the criteria specified for transfers in 'Para 3.2' of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 to reiterate that services of Applicant while he was serving as 'Police Inspector, C.I.D., Jalgaon' from 15.05.2021 to 03.09.2021 was not to be counted in tenure of '3 years' in last '4 Years' within 'Pune District'. 3. Learned P.O. on other hand states that as the entire tenure in 'Pune District' from 01.07.2020 onwards is required to be counted and as Applicant had joined in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Pimri-Chinchwad' on 01.07.2020 as 'A.P.I' but subsequently went on promotion as 'Police Inspector' to serve in 'C.I.D. - Jalgaon' from 15.05.2021 to 03.09.2021 but again came back to serve as 'Police Inspector' in establishment of 'Superintendent of Police, Pune (Rural)', the total tenure of Applicant within 'Pune District' would therefore be more than '3 Years' in last '4 Years' before 30.06.2024. Hence, Applicant has been justifiably transferred by 'Transfer Order' dated 24.02.2024 of 'Special I.G.P. Kolhapur Range, Kolhapur' to establishment of 'Superintendent of Police, Satara'. 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon states that Applicant is willing to join at place of new posting in establishment of 'Superintendent of Police, Satara' as per 'Transfer Order' dated 24.02.2024 by [P.T.O.]

Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents. 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant was transferred from post of 'Chief Officer, Daund, Municipal Council', to post of Deputy Commissioner, Solapur Municipal Corporation' by Transfer Order dated 02.02.2024 of Urban Development Department. 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that, Respondent No. 4 was posted as 'Chief Officer, Daund, Municipal Council, District Pune' by Transfer Order dated 26.03.2024 of Urban Development Department. 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then draws attention to subsequent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 27.02.2024 to emphasize that transfers of 'ERO/AERO' are no longer required to be done as posts of 'EROs/AEROs' which were earlier included in 'Para 5.1' of the directions in Election Commission letter dated 21.12.2023 have been removed from subsequent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 27.02.2024. 5. Learned Advocate for Applicant also states that Respondent No.4, who was transferred in place of Applicant by Transfer Order dated 26.02.2024 of Urban Development Department has taken 'ex parte' charge of the post of 'Chief Officer, Municipal Council, Daund, District Pune'. 6. Learned P.O. states that Transfer Order dated 02.02.2024 of Urban Development Department has been issued in respect of all officers who were designated as 'EROs/AEROs' but were serving in their 'Home Districts' as per earlier directions in 'Para 5.1' of Election of Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023.

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7. Learned P.O. further states that therefore the Transfer Order dated 02.02.2024 of 'Urban Development Department' was issued to implement in letter & spirit the earlier directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023.

8. Learned P.O. further states that Applicants who was posted as 'Deputy Commissioner, Solapur, Municipal Corporation' as per Transfer Order 02.02.2024 of Urban Development Department should have joined and then no such occasion would have arisen to contend for retrospective implementation of subsequent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 27.02.2024.

9. The contention of Applicant is to retrospectively implement subsequent directions in Election Commission of India letter on 27.02.2024. Almost all officers other than Applicant would have reported to Join in new places of postings as per Transfer Order dated 02.02.2024 of 'Urban Development Department'. Nonetheless, the case of Applicant is limited to post of 'Chief Officer, Municipal Council, Daund, District Pune' where he had joined on 05.04.2023. Thus in the aforesaid context how far it would be practicable to retrospectively implement subsequent directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 27.02.2024 needs to be examined diligently by 'Urban Development Department' for which they may seek advice from 'Principal Secretary, Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State'.

10. Learned PO to also inform 'Principal Secretary-II', Urban Development Department to produce the 'File Notings' as to what were the compelling reasons for 'Respondent No. 4' to be urgently posted by Transfer Order dated 26.02.2024 of Urban Development to post of 'Chief Officer, Municipal Council, Daund, District Pune'.

Khaire, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Ms S.P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</p> <p>2. The Applicant prays for declaration that Applicant is eligible for the post of 'Staff Nurse' under 'ST General' category and Order dated 27.02.2024 passed by Respondent No.3 disqualifying the Applicant for the said post is to be quashed and set aside.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel for Applicant submits that Advertisement dated 28.08.2023 was published by Respondent No.2 for various posts including 'Staff Nurse'. Learned Counsel further submits that after publishing first Advertisement, the Respondent made changes in the Advertisement. As per the earlier Advertisement, 2 separate educational qualifications were prescribed for Staff Nurse Government (50% quota) and Staff Nurse Private (50% quota). Thus, as per the said Advertisement, candidates possessing GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery Diploma) qualification were not eligible to apply for 50% quota to be filled in from 'Private' nursing college. Only candidates possessing B.Sc (nursing degree) were eligible to apply for 50% quota to be filled in from 'Private' nursing college. As the Applicant possessed GNM qualification, she was eligible to apply only for 50% quota to be filled in from Government College. Hence, she applied in Government quota. Learned Counsel then submits that</p>

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later on Respondent published revised Advertisement and clarified that candidates possessing GNM qualification and B.Sc. (Nursing) degree are eligible to apply for 50% quota to be filled in from Private Nursing College and 50% Government quota on the basis of Institution through which they have obtained their educational qualification namely GNM & B.B.sc.

4. Learned Counsel for Applicant states that Advertisement was amended without there being any notice, corrigendum to that effect. As per the new Advertisement, the separate educational qualification for Government and Private quota was changed and same educational qualification for both the quota was applied. The educational qualification as per earlier and new Advertisement dated 28.08.2023 reads as under :-
