Shri Bandiwadekar, Ld. Advocate states that the Applicant retired on 31.10.2012 and without any prior notice the impugned order has been passed. Certain amounts have already been recovered and recovery may continue till April, 2017. Shri Bandiwadekar, Ld. Advocate, therefore, sought interim relief that no further recoveries from the pension of the applicant be made till final disposal of this OA. He cited the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 18.12.2014 in Civil Appeal No.11527 of 2014 STATE OF PUNJAB & ORS VERSUS RAFIQ MASIH (WHITE WASHER) ETC. Ld. It is equally clear that the matter relates to the seniority list and it is likely to take some time, as and by way of last and final opportunity, making it clear that no further extension shall be granted.
