Punam Mahajan, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned P.O. for Respondents.</p> <p>2. The Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 06.08.2021 on the ground that her options were not considered in terms of G.R. dated 09.04.2018 which <i>inter-alia</i> provides for giving preference to a Government servant whose parents suffer from serious ailment like Cancer, etc. The Applicant was due for transfer and has given 10 options. He had also submitted Medical Certificate of his mother. However, none of the option was considered and he was transferred at Adgaon Circle, Tamhini which was not in the options given by him.</p> <p>3. Now, general transfers of 2022 are ensuing and hardly one month away.</p> <p>3. In view of above, learned Advocate for the Applicant submitted that in general transfers of 2022, Applicant's case is required to be considered and her client is ready to make fresh representation.</p> <p>4. The perusal of record reveals that none of option given by the Applicant was considered though it ought to have been considered in terms of G.R. dated 09.04.2018 in view of Medical Certificate submitted by him. Applicant's mother is suffering from Blood Cancer. Indeed, G.R. dated 09.04.2018 provides for transfer on counselling and giving preference to a Government servant whose parents suffer from serious illness like Cancer, etc. No reason for denying options are forthcoming. Even if G.R. dated 09.04.2018 does not vests right in favour of Applicant to ask for particular post or place, but in view of policy decision taken by Government itself, it was obligatory to consider the difficulties and to issue transfer order in fair and transparent manner and in letter and spirit of G.R. dated 09.04.2018.</p>

6. If for one or other reason, general transfers are not effected by the end of May, 2022, in that event, also, the decision on the representation shall be taken at the end of May, 2022.

This O.A. is filed for direction to the Respondents to release retiral benefits which are withheld for no reasons.</p> <p>3. The Applicant stands retired on 31.08.2018 from the post of Talathi. At the time of retirement he was on the establishment of Respondent No.2 – Tahasildar, Jawahar, Dist. Palghar. Respondent No.1 is S.D.O – Jawahar, Dist. Palghar and controlling authority of Respondent No. 2 – Tahasildar. It is really disgusting that though the Applicant stands retired on 31.08.2018 he was not paid retiral benefits and after waiting for long time compelled to approach this Tribunal.</p> <p>4. O.A. was taken up for admission on 07.04.2022 and having found the Applicant's retiral benefits are withheld for long time, directions were given to learned P.O. to taken instructions from the Respondents and to appraise the Tribunal as to why retiral benefits are not paid. Respondent No.1 – Jawahar was also directed to keep responsible officer present to know the reason for withholding retiral benefits. Thereafter, matter was taken up twice for taking instructions from the Respondents.</p> <p>5. Today learned P.O. on instructions submits that retiral benefits are not paid due to non-updation of the service book of the Applicant. She admits that at the time of retirement neither there was initiation of [P.T.O.</p>

	<p>criminal prosecution nor departmental proceeding was pending so as to withhold retiral benefits.</p> <p>6. As such, what transpires that there was absolutely no legal hurdle for withholding retiral benefits. However, retiral benefits are withheld for more than four years due to sheer laxity and negligence on the part of concerned officials.</p> <p>7. Indeed, Rule 122 of M.C.S. (Pension) Rules, 1982 specifically provides that the Head of Office shall complete the process of compliance of pension papers no later than six months before the date of retirement of the Government servant. Rules 120 to 122 provides time frame for verification of service record including service book and preparation of pension papers well in advance. Despite this specific provision in Pension Rules, 1982, Respondents did not bother and the Applicant is deprived of his legitimate retiral benefits for more than four years. Lapses, Laxity and negligence on the part of concerned Official is obvious.</p> <p>8. In view of above, O.A. deserves to be disposed of with suitable direction.</p> <p>9. O.A. is disposed of with direction to the Respondents to take all necessary steps for updation of service book, verification of service record etc and to ensure release of all retiral benefits of the Applicant as per his entitlement in law within a month from today.</p> <p>10.
