- 2. In this O.A., the Applicant has challenged the suspension order dated 17.10.2022 issued by Respondent /Collector, Pune suspending her in contemplation of D.E.
- 3. While the Applicant was serving as Circle Officer, Bhosari, she came to be suspended by order dated 17.10.2022 in contemplation of D.E. attributing certain misconduct to her. In suspension order, it is alleged that Applicant has change the order of mutation which she earlier passed without following due process of law and thereby committed misconduct. In suspension order, the Respondent further alleged that Applicant kept 67 matters for mutation pending and despite issuance of show cause notice, she failed to improve her performance. It is on this allegation, the Applicant came to be suspended invoking Rule 4(1) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979 in contemplation of regular D.E.
  - 4. Heard learned Counsel for the Applicant as well as learned P.O. for quite some time. During the course of hearing, learned Counsel for the Applicant sought to contend that it was not a case of warranting suspension and all that Applicant's discharged quasi judicial function. He has further pointed out that after suspension though the Applicant is reinstated by order dated 07.02.2023 till date no further steps are taken to initiate the D.E. In alternative submission, he prayed to disposed of O.A. with suitable directions so that D.E. if instituted in reasonable time, it could be taken to the logical conclusion within stipulated period. Thus, one is not pressing to declare the suspension illegal.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 5. Learned P.O. sought to justify the suspension order inter-alia contending that in view of contrary orders passed by the Applicant while sanctioning mutation entries, the cognizance was taken by the Collector and there was enough material for her suspension. As regard, initiation of D.E. she submits that though till date no D.E. is initiated by issuance of charge sheet, now steps are being taken to issue charge sheet and it will be completed within reasonable time.
- Applicant was suspended by order dated 17.10.2022, later she was reinstated in service by order dated 07.02.2023 by giving her posting at Tahsil office, Bhor as a Awal Karkoon. However, though the period of more than six months from the date of suspension is over, the Respondents failed to initiate the D.E. for alleged misconduct for which Applicant was suspended. Indeed, as per various circulars and instructions issued by the Government, the D.E. ought to have been initiated and completed within six months. However, in present case till date no D.E. is initiated which shows lethargy on the part of Respondents.
- 7. In view of above, particularly since the Applicant is reinstated in service though at different places, it would be appropriate to dispose of the O.A. with suitable directions.
- 8 O.A. is disposed of with directions to respondents to initiate D.E. against the Applicant for alleged misconduct for which she was suspended by order dated 17.10.2022 within a month from today and further to ensure that D.E. is completed within four months from the date of issuance of charge sheet including passing final order therein in accordance to law.
- 9. If the Respondents failed to initiate D.E. within a month as directed above, the Applicant will have to be reposted at the place where she was serving at the time of suspension and then to proceed with D.E. in accordance to law.

Therefore, O.A. ought to have been filed on or before 01.06.2022. However, it is filed on 09.01.2023. As such , the delay is not of one year as stated in M.A. but it is seven months. The Applicant is retired Government servant and claiming third benefit in terms of G.R. dated 02.03.2019.
- 7. In the interest of justice and taking justice oriented approach, I am inclined to condone the delay so as to decide the O.A. on merit.
- 8. For the aforesaid reasons, M.A.No.17/2023 is allowed and delay is condoned.
- 9. No order as to costs.

- 4. When the matter is taken up for admission hearing, on 13.04.2023 and 17.04.2023, it is noticed that Respondent No.1 himself by communication dated 15.02.2023 informed about the vacancy position and that time did not object for absorption on whatever ground.
